

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

**ITEMIZED CHARGES**

**A. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff ..... \$1,350.00**

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filling of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, administrative cost, and equipment and inventory expenses. The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

**B. Transfer of Remains to the Funeral Home (within a 45-mile radius)..... \$450.00**  
**C. Second Attendant (if necessary) ..... \$100.00**  
**D. Embalming ..... \$700.00**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

**N. Service/Utility/Flower Vehicle (within a 45-mile radius)..... \$250.00**  
*O. Transportation outside of the radius will be charged \$3.50 per mile thereafter*  
**P. Use of equipment and staff for graveside service..... \$450.00**  
**Q. Additional charge for Weekend Service ..... \$800.00**  
**R. Conducting Off Premise Service ..... \$450.00**  
**S. Additional charge for Evening Service ..... \$300.00**  
**T. Processing and Filing of Creditor’s Claim Against the Estate ..... 10% of total**  
**U. Processing and Filing Insurance Claim ..... 5% of total**

<b>A. Forwarding of the Deceased to Another Mortuary</b> .....	<b>\$2,480.00</b>
This charge includes transfer of the deceased to our mortuary, minimum services of the funeral director and staff, embalming and local transportation.	
<b>B. Receiving Deceased from Another Mortuary</b> .....	<b>\$1,480.00</b>
This charge includes minimum services of the funeral director and staff, care of the deceased and transportation of the deceased to the cemetery for burial.	
<b>C. Immediate Burial</b> .....	<b>\$2,150.00 to \$7,100.00</b>
This charge includes transfer of the deceased to our mortuary, minimum services of the funeral director and staff, and local transportation.	
A. With container provided by purchaser .....	<b>\$2,150.00</b>
B. Including minimum casket selected from our funeral home .....	<b>\$2,850.00</b>
<b>D. Direct Cremation</b> .....	<b>\$1,190.00 to \$6,140.00</b>
Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes local transfer of deceased to the mortuary, minimum services of the funeral director and staff, and cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The type of container we provide is fiberboard.
