Professional Services Federal Trade Commission (FTC) Disclosure.

The following goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services of the funeral directors, staff and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing in detail the goods and services selected.

Other Disclosures.

*This list may not include prices for certain items you select, such as cemetery charges or crematory services, flowers, and newspaper notices. The estimated or final prices for those items will be shown on the itemized statement describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected. We charge you for our services in buying certain items.

*The provider of funeral services is required to give price information in person and over the telephone.

* A provider of funeral services is prohibited from representing that the deterioration of human remains can be prevented for more than a limited time by embalming, caskets, vaults or outer interment receptacles.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CHARGES:

Basic Service of Funeral Director, Staff & Overhead **\$2,350.00**

This is our basic charge to each family we serve for our professional expertise in their assistance. It includes but is not limited to a proportionate share of taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses to serve the public in a respectful and professional manner. Included in this is the consultation with the family; clerical and administrative services; preparation and filing of necessary permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; and consultation with clergy, cemetery, and crematory or common carrier involved in the funeral service. This charge for our basic services of the funeral director, staff and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This charge is already included in our other charges for direct cremations, immediate burial and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming **\$1,500.00**

Embalming is a chemical process which provides preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by the state of Texas must complete the procedure; except in special circumstances embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you select funeral arrangements such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it (such as direct cremation or immediate burial). In the state of Texas, a body must be embalmed or refrigerated if burial or cremation will not occur within 24 hours of death.

Other Care of the Deceased **\$ 400.00**

Dressing, casketing, cosmetology, hairdressing, special attention, care of garments for remains, bathing, surface disinfection of un-embalmed remains, and may also include setting of features for viewing.

FACILITIES, STAFF & EQUIPMENT:

Public Viewing or Visitation \$400.00

This charge includes use of our equipment and staff for a public viewing or visitation at our facility or at another local facility. It also includes transferring to place of viewing, transportation and use of funeral home in-state equipment with necessary supplies, setting-up visiting areas, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, supervision and attendance by the funeral home staff.

Funeral or Memorial Service Conducted at Funeral Home \$500.00

This charge includes our facilities, staff and equipment for a small intimate service at our facility conducted in our funeral parlor. It also includes use of funeral home in-state equipment with necessary supplies, setting-up visiting areas, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, and supervision and hospitality of funeral home staff.

Funeral or Memorial Service Conducted at Another Local Facility \$650.00

This charge includes our staff and in-state equipment for a service conducted at another local facility. It also includes use of funeral home in-state equipment with necessary supplies, setting-up visiting areas, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, and supervision of funeral home staff.

Graveside Service (Casket not included) \$550.00

This charge includes our staff and funeral home equipment for a graveside service conducted at the cemetery. (Does not include casket or cemetery equipment.) Our services include accompaniment of remains to the cemetery, supervision of graveside service, receiving and arrangement of florals and other memorial tributes at the graveside, and follow-up attention to related details connected with the graveside services.

(An additional charge of \$3.50 per loaded mile will be charged after 45 miles.)

MINIMAL SERVICES:

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home **\$4,700.00**

This charge does not include merchandise, shipping charges, facility uses, visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of remains. This charge includes basic service of funeral director, staff and overhead, transfer of remains to the funeral establishment (within a 30 mile radius), embalming, securing necessary authorizations and permits, and transportation to the airport. (Airline does require a container for shipping.) ***Does not include cash advance items.**

Air Tray Container (required by airlines) **\$290.00**

Shipping within the United States **\$650.00 and up**

International Shipping **\$1,150.00 and up**

Acquiring Permits **\$350.00**

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home **\$2,850.00**

This charge includes basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead. Securing necessary authorizations, and funeral coach (hearse). This charge does not include additional items of services, merchandise or facility uses. ***Does not include cash advance items.**

Immediate Burial **\$3,200.00**

This service includes the basic professional services of the funeral director & staff, obtaining legal documents, initial call vehicle, refrigeration, sanitary care of the remains, temporary shelter of remains (up to 2 days), and transportation to the local cemetery. The burial day and time will be at the funeral home's convenience. It does not include embalming, other preparation of the remains, visitation or viewing, equipment, use of facilities for services, automotive equipment except as specifically set forth above, merchandise such as alternative container or casket, or cash advance items.

Non-Ceremonial Simple Direct Cremation **\$2,195.00**

This service includes basic professional services of funeral director & staff, obtaining and filing legal documents, initial call vehicle, refrigeration, temporary shelter of remains (the crematory can charge a storage fee if an unreasonable amount of time is taken to get cremation authorization is ted by family members), sanitary care of deceased, and transportation to the crematory. It does not include embalming, other preparation of remains, viewing or visitation, equipment, use of facilities for services, automotive equipment except as specifically set forth above, merchandise such as alternative container or casket, cash advance items or crematory fee. Charges may be higher for cases that require extra staff for the first call, additional staff at the crematory and additional crematory charges. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition material (with or without an outside covering.) The containers we provide are made of fiberboard and composition material units.

PAYMENT POLICY:

Steven G. Hill's House of Funerals is an independently owned and operated establishment like many others within our community. Out of necessity we operate on a cash basis, being totally dependent upon the families we service for prompt payment. The management and staff of Steven G. Hill's House of Funerals are dedicated in providing sensitive, professional service to the communities in and around North Texas. In keeping with that Credo, we feel a responsibility to offer several different payment options to those we serve, recognizing that in many instances, the family has had little or no time to anticipate or prepare for the costs associated with funeral services. It is also imperative to be realistic in respect to the funeral expenditures of today. We do not want any family to spend more or less than they would like. Our goal is paradigm in assisting a family in arranging a fitting farewell that is within their financial constraints. Payment in full is expected after arrangements are completed and before services are scheduled. At the end of the arrangement conference you will be presented with a contract itemizing the goods and services that you requested. For your convenience the following payment methods are accepted.

METHODS OF PAYMENT:

- **Cash, Money Orders, Verified Check Payments** (NO Personal Checks will be accepted within 48 hours of services.
- **Credit Card Payments** - We accept (All Major Credit Cards) *please note that a 4% surcharge is required for processing.
- **Life Insurance Policies** – If you choose to use a Life Insurance Policy, required is a 5% processing charge of the total contract amount or 5% of the assignable insurance amount involved for this payment method, and will be added to the total charges on your statement of funeral goods and services. We do not accept insurance policies under 2years of age, for they are usually contestable and therefore cannot be used as a secure form of payment. Please do not hesitate to call our Licensed Funeral Directors with any questions.
- **Prearranged Funeral Plans** – We honor and accept prearranged (prepaid funeral plans purchased before death) that were written through our funeral home. On a case-by-case basis, we will also honor prearranged funeral plans that were written at another funeral home. If you would like to use a prearranged funeral plan as a form of payment that was written at another funeral home, please contact one of our Licensed Funeral Directors.

ALL PAYMENTS FOR SERVICES ARE REQUIRED 48 HOURS PRIOR TO SERVICES
