Charges for Services Selected

In our statement of funeral goods and services, the first section lists the itemized charges for the selected services. Included in this section are the charges for professional services, facilities, and automotive equipment. Families choosing a traditional funeral have two options. The first option is to itemize these charges. The second option is the Traditional Funeral package, which includes the following:

- ❖ Professional services of the funeral director and staff
- ❖ Local transfer of the deceased to the funeral home
- ❖ Embalming, restoration, and casketing of your loved one
- ❖ Implementation of funeral arrangements by coordination with the clergy, cemetery, musicians, florist, etc.
- ❖ Liaison with the physician, medical examiner, or coroner
- ❖ Procurement of necessary permits and authorizations
- ❖ Preparation and placement of media announcements
- ❖ Memorial stationary package with register book, memorial cards, and thank you notes
- ❖ Use of the funeral home and equipment for viewing hours (one day) and for the funeral services (one Day) or other location as selected by the family
- ❖ Use of the hearse, lead, car, and service vehicle

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

Responding to the initial request, conducting the arrangement conference, preparation of biographical and statistical data, examination of financial settlement options, preparation, and filing of papers, permits, and authorizations; coordination with those providing other services. Preparation and placement of newspaper notice; retention and care prior to commencement of post-death activities; overhead expenses relative to our facilities and operations, such as occupancy, administrative, and equipment costs.

(This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

Embalming \$ 850.00

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. (This cost includes the use of the preparation room.)
