Any funeral arrangement you select will include a charge for our **Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff**, which reflects the professional care, coordination, and availability required for every service we provide. If legal or other requirements require you to purchase any item you did not specifically request, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement of goods and services you receive.

Traditional Funeral Service — \$6,960

A traditional funeral service typically includes visitation, a funeral service, and committal at the cemetery.

This service includes:

- Removal and transfer of the deceased to the funeral home
- Professional care of the deceased, including embalming, cosmetizing, dressing, and casketing
- Consultation with the family regarding visitation, funeral, and committal arrangements
- Preparation and filing of all necessary authorizations and documents
- Use of facilities and staff for visitation, including a private family viewing if desired
- Staff and supervision for the funeral service at the location of your choice
- Staff and supervision for committal services and post-service activities

- Use of the hearse and necessary vehicles within the local area
- Transportation of floral tributes to the cemetery or another requested location
- Funeral register book and acknowledgment cards
- Continuous professional care and attention throughout the entire process

This service includes the Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff.

Services of the Funeral Director and Staff

If you prefer a service other than the Traditional Funeral Service, the following prices allow you to select only the services you desire.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff — \$3,395

This charge includes:

- Initial consultation and arrangement conference with the responsible party
- Preparation and filing of necessary permits, notices, and authorizations
- Coordination of service details with clergy, cemetery, crematory, and other parties involved
- Professional supervision and availability throughout the arrangement process

This fee is included in the charges for Direct Cremation, Immediate Burial, and Forwarding or Receiving of Remains.

Additional Services of Funeral Director and Staff

- Coordination and direction of a funeral or memorial service, including necessary facilities, at the funeral home or another location — **\$545**
- Supervision and facilities for visitation, including arrangement of floral tributes (each night or portion of a day) — **\$545**
- Supervision and facilities for a private family viewing — **\$300**
- Supervision for committal services at the cemetery or crematory — **\$425**

Care and Preparation of the Deceased

- Embalming — **\$895**

Embalming is the sanitary and preservative preparation of the body by a licensed professional using universal precautions. Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you select certain arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you may choose an option that does not require it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

- Standard cosmetic care, dressing, and casketing — **\$335**
 - Special care of autopsied cases (additional) — **\$375**
 - Special care of donor cases (additional) — **\$395**
 - Special or extensive restorative care (per hour) — **\$300**

Transportation and Equipment

- Local transfer of the deceased to the funeral home — **\$595**
- Use of hearse — **\$325**
- Use of limousine — **\$200**
- Use of utility vehicle — **\$125**

For transportation outside the local area (greater than 50 miles one way), an additional charge of **\$2.50 per loaded mile per vehicle** will apply.

- Transportation to or from Chicago or St. Louis — **\$495**
- Transportation to or from Iowa City — **\$295**

Direct Cremation

Our charge for direct cremation without any ceremony includes:

- Removal and shelter of the deceased
- Transportation to the crematory
- Minimum professional staff services

Crematory fees and cremation permits are cash advance items.

Cremation will be performed as soon as practical but may take up to two weeks.

- Direct cremation with private identification viewing and obituary posting — **\$3,395**
- Direct cremation with no viewing and no obituary (information gathered for death certificate only) — **\$2,995**

If you choose direct cremation, you may use an alternative container. Alternative containers are designed to encase the body and may be made of fiberboard or similar materials. The alternative containers we provide are constructed of cardboard. Please see our detailed Cremation Price List for additional options.

Immediate Burial

Immediate burial includes removal and shelter of the deceased, transportation to the cemetery, and minimum professional staff services. Cemetery charges are cash advance items.

- Immediate burial with casket provided by the purchaser — **\$3,752**
- Immediate burial with casket purchased from the funeral home (casket price additional) — **\$3,752**

Merchandise

Caskets

- Burial caskets — **from \$1,500 to \$7,500**
A complete casket price list will be provided at the funeral home.

Outer Burial Containers

- Outer burial containers — **from \$900 to \$15,500**
A complete outer burial container price list will be provided at the funeral home.

Alternatives to Traditional Funeral Service Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home — **\$3,187**

Includes removal and shelter of the deceased, minimum staff services, preparation of necessary authorizations, embalming, and local transportation. Shipping charges are not included.

Receiving of Remains from Another Funeral Home — **\$2,147**

Includes minimum staff services, care and shelter of the deceased, and local transportation to the cemetery.
