

# COVID-19 Statement

As you are aware our Governor has set specific protocols for large gatherings in the State of Ohio. We are allowed and will continue to serve our families during this most unprecedented time and to provide an avenue which your family can safely celebrate your loved one and process through the grieving stages.

At this time during COVID-19 we are limiting contact in line with the social distancing mandates and are meeting with as many of our families for arrangements via telephone and internet. Drop off of clothing and other funeral related needs will be arranged. If you request an in-person arrangement, we are asking to limit it to the immediate family ONLY (no more than four persons) and as mandated MASKS MUST BE WORN in the building at all times. For the private family viewing we are allowing only 10 people in the chapel.

Also we are encouraging our families to keep services on/at our facility location, (in our chapel), for many churches are still closed for their regular scheduled services. Our chapel is now configured with ONLY 50 CHAIRS spaced out for social distancing. We are not at this time providing limousine service. Our refreshment counter and lounge area have been CLOSED for consumption of coffee, water, beverages at this time. Our staff will do it's best to disinfect the public areas after each service.

Also during this pandemic season we are not keeping regular office hours. In an effort to keep our staff safe, we will be working offsite as much as possible. We are available for appointments however.
