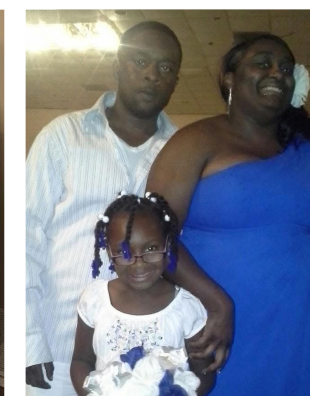
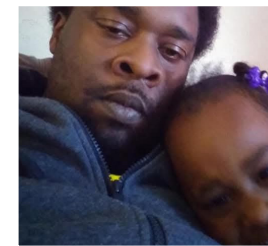
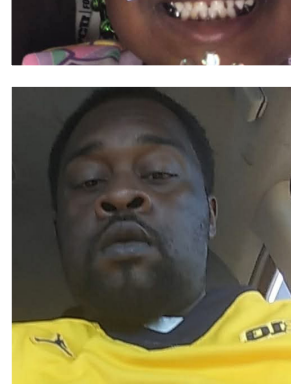
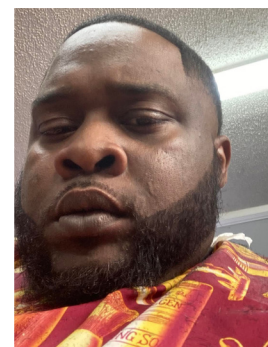
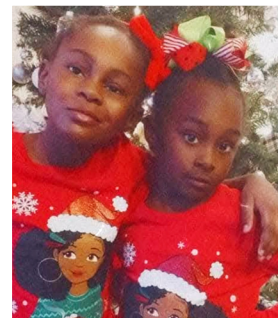
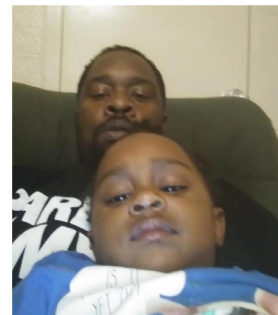
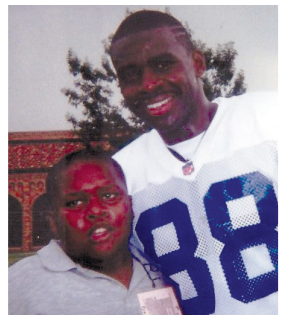
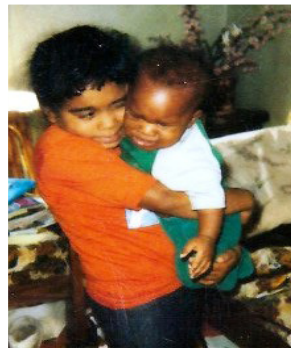
The highlight of Anthony's life was without a doubt the birth of his children, whom he adored and cherished. He often spoke lovingly about them, finding immense joy in his role as a father.
