**GENERAL PRICE LIST** *These prices are effective as of October 1, 2016 but thereafter subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.*

**PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR & STAFF 2,000**

*Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as sheltering of remains, professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses*

*This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)*

**SERVICES AND FACILITY FEES**

*Visitation at the Funeral Home or Church: Our services will include set up of visitation, use of visitation area, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, parking lot assistance, and supervision and attendance during the visitation.*

- A. Visitation Day Before Service ..... **400**
- B. Visitation the Day of Service ..... **250**
- C. Private Family Viewing ..... **200**
- D. Visitation Following Service and Prior to Committal ..... **250**

- **Funeral Ceremony** ..... **600**

*Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangements, supervision of funeral, staff to attend the funeral ceremony, supervision of committal or other disposition service, and set-up and use of facilities for funeral ceremony.*

- **Graveside Service** ..... **500**

*Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangement at graveside, supervision of the graveside service, and equipment and staff necessary to conduct the graveside service.*

- **Memorial Service**..... **500**

*Our services include coordinating the memorial service, supervision of the memorial service, staff to attend memorial service, and set-up and use of facilities for memorial service.*

**EMBALMING**

*Except in certain special cases, \*embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.*

- Standard Embalming ..... **800**
- Autopsy, Organ, Tissue Cases ..... **1,200**

*\* Embalming is not required by law however, it is our policy that if a family chooses not to select embalming, a private viewing must be held within 24 hours and remains must be buried within 36 hours, or incur extra charges for refrigeration.*

**OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY**

- A. Identification prior to direct disposition ..... **150**
- B. Washing and disinfecting remains when no embalming ... **300**
- C. Refrigeration per day of unembalmed remains ..... **75**
- D. Dressing, cosmetizing and casketing ..... **300**
- E. Reconstructive restoration when necessary (per hour) ... **150**
- F. Removal of Pacemaker, or any other Medical Device necessary for Cremation or otherwise ..... **100**

**AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT**

(Add 2.50 for each mile outside 25 mile local service radius).

- Hearse ..... **200**

**FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME**

This charge includes removal of remains, basic services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to airport. This charges does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

- A. With minimum shipping container..... **3,400**
- B. With casket selected from our funeral home ..... **3,200**

(In addition to the cost of the casket)

**RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME... 2,450**

This charge includes: transfer of remains to funeral home, transportation of remains to cemetery and basic services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, funeral/graveside service or grave digging and set up fees. Optional Graveside Funeral Service..... **3,150**

**DIRECT CREMATION ..... 3,250 to 11,150**

The charge for a direct cremation includes basic services of the staff, transfer of remains, local transportation to crematory, securing and filing legal documents, courier vehicle, refrigeration of remains for up to 24 hours and crematory fee. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are wood cremation caskets and fiberboard boxes.

- Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser .... **3,250**
- Direct cremation with a fiberboard container ..... **3,350**
- Direct Cremation with Cremation Casket and or Shroud Selected From Our Funeral Home..... **3,250**

(Casket or Shroud Additional Cost)

**IMMEDIATE BURIAL ..... 2,600 to 10,600**

The charge for immediate burial includes basic services of staff, removal of remains, courier vehicle, local transportation to the cemetery,. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial.

- Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser ..... **2,600**
- Immediate burial with casket and or shroud selected from our funeral home..... **2,400**

(Casket or shroud Additional Cost)

**DIRECT BODY DONATION..... 2,400**

The charge for direct body donation includes basic services of staff, removal of remains,, courier vehicle, transportation of remains to funeral home within a 25 mile radius and to Medical School in North Carolina within a 100 mile radius. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial.

**DISINTERMENT/REINTERMENT .....1,500**

The charge for disinterment/reinterment includes: securing all necessary paperwork and signatures; registering legal documents with local health department; a licensed funeral director to oversee all work and to be sure remains are handled with utmost respect. This fee does not include the cost of grave digging fees, necessary equipment and manpower to disinter and re-inter the vault, or mileage fees charged by the vault company.
