

PACKAGE SELECTIONS

These are package selections that offer a discount off of our itemized General Price List. They are available only if the casket is purchased from Duggan’s Mission Chapel. If the casket is provided by the family, we will itemize all charges that would have been packaged together and discounted in listed packages. No credit is offered if some services in these packages are not utilized. These prices do not include the casket, cash advance items, sales taxes, cemetery charges, residential or after-hours transport fees, or transport made out-of-area. These prices are for services being held Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. and viewings or visitations up to 7 p.m. “Local” services pertain to those within the City of Sonoma and communities immediately adjacent.

1. Traditional Burial Funeral Package\$3,495

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing of remains, visitation or viewing at the funeral home (4 hours), funeral ceremony at funeral home or local church (2 hours), hearse, flower car, local cemetery committal ceremony, register book, and 25 acknowledgment cards.

2. Graveside Committal With No Viewing Package\$2,595

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, refrigeration, washing and disinfecting of unembalmed remains, hearse, local cemetery committal ceremony, register book, and 25 acknowledgment cards. *A flower car is not included in this package.*

3. Immediate Burial With No Ceremonies Package\$1,995

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, refrigeration, washing and disinfecting of unembalmed remains, and service/utility vehicle for delivery to local cemetery. *A hearse is not included in this package. This package is for families NOT attending the cemetery burial.*

4. Traditional Cremation Funeral Package\$3,495

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing of remains, visitation or viewing at the funeral home (4 hours), funeral ceremony at funeral home or local church (2 hours), local automotive equipment if having local church service, the actual cremation process (at our on-site crematory), temporary plastic urn, register book, and 25 acknowledgment cards.

5. Cremation With Memorial Service Package\$2,295

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, refrigeration, memorial ceremony at funeral home or local church (2 hours), the actual cremation process (at our on-site crematory), alternative cremation container (corrugated fiberboard), temporary plastic urn, register book, and 25 acknowledgment cards.

6. Direct Cremation Package\$1,725

Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, refrigeration, the actual cremation process (at our on-site crematory), alternative cremation container (corrugated fiberboard), and a temporary plastic urn.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods and services, the responsible party or the decedent’s survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

PAYMENT TERMS

It is our payment policy that all expenses for services and merchandise be paid in full by the responsible party at time of arrangements, prior to the services being rendered.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead\$2,050
Includes a discussion with you and implementation of desired arrangements; preparing, securing signatures and death certificate; obtaining necessary releases and burial or cremation permit; clerical and staff personnel to prepare necessary documents; use of the mortuary building, etc. Our overhead is a proportionate share of operating costs including, but not limited to: taxes, licenses, utilities, fees, insurance and staff salaries. This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

Embalming\$500
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. For health and sanitation reasons, the State of California requires either refrigeration or embalming 24 hours after death.

Direct cremation (per itemized rates) \$2,270 to \$8,720
Includes: Basic services of funeral director, staff and overhead, local transfer of deceased to funeral home, refrigeration, alternative cremation container (corrugated fiberboard), the actual cremation process (at our on-site crematory) and a temporary plastic urn. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of corrugated fiberboard and various woods.

Forwarding of remains to another funeral director\$2,359

Does not include casket, airfare or other cash advances, or items chosen by purchaser to be added as needed.
