The goods and services shown are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangement you select will include a charge for our professional services. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery lots, crematory services, flowers, and newspaper obituary notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement of goods and services describing the funeral goods and services you selected. We may charge you for our services in buying these items.

Packaged Selections

Traditional Funeral Service

This charge **includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff**, removal and transfer of remains to funeral home within a 20 mile radius, embalming and other preparation of the body, temporary shelter of remains, use of facilities and staff for evening and morning visitation/viewing, funeral ceremony in our chapel, graveside committal or other disposition service, use of hearse, flower vehicle, and a proportionate share of operating expenses.

Direct Cremation

This charge **includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff**, transfer of remains within 20 mi. radius, temporary shelter, proportionate share of operating expenses, filing of necessary authorizations, and crematory fee. This charge does **not** include the use of facilities and staff for visitation, rites or ceremonies, cemetery charges or Coroner's Permit. *(If you select Direct Cremation, you may use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials with or without an outside covering. The container we provide is a fiberboard container).*

Immediate Burial & Anatomical Donation

This charge **includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff**, removal of remains within 20-mile radius, temporary shelter, proportionate share of operating expenses, and necessary authorizations. This charge does **not** include the use of facilities and staff for visitation and/or rites or ceremonies, or cemetery charges. *(If you want to arrange an immediate burial, you may use an alternative container. The container we provide is a fiberboard container).*

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home **\$3,800**

This charge **includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff**, removal of remains, embalming, necessary authorizations, shipping container and local transportation to airport. It does **not** include airline charges or the use of facilities and staff for visitation/rites or ceremonies or the cost of transportation in funeral home vehicle outside the 20-mile radius of funeral home which is \$1.25 per mile, round trip.

Receiving Remains from another Funeral Home **\$1,650**

Includes required services of Funeral Director and Staff, temporary shelter of the remains and a proportionate share of operating expenses. (This charge does **not** include the use of facilities and staff for visitation, rites or ceremonies, automotive expenses, cemetery or crematory fees or mileage to airport beyond a 20 mile radius.)

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$3,300*

Our professional service charge includes but may not be limited to: staff to respond to initial request for service, arrangement conference and consultation with family and clergy, recording vital statistics, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms, notifications and permits, placement of obituary notices, and coordination of service plans with third parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.

This fee for our basic services and operating expenses will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This Fee, or a portion thereof, is already included in our charge for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.

Embalming

Embalming of Autopsied Remains

\$1,600

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
