

It is our intent to serve our families as completely as possible; however, the mortuary is restricted on obtaining death certificates. The mortuary may only apply on behalf of the following:

Surviving Spouse
Parents
Children
Siblings
Grandparents

Anyone else needing to obtain a death certificate (Attorney, Executor, Friend, etc.) within the first 30 days from the date of death may apply directly to the county where the death occurred.

When applying for the certificate, applicants MUST provide proper identification and have a notarized copy of the will of the deceased or show legal interest. The office may require additional information.
