

What Is Cremation?

Cremation is the process of returning the body to nature with the use of heat and evaporation. This practice has been in use for centuries and is accepted worldwide. More and more people from all social, religious and economic backgrounds are choosing cremation as an alternative to the complicated and expensive traditional funeral. In some states, the cremation rate is higher than 60 percent.

How cremation works

During a cremation, the casket or container holding the deceased is placed in the cremation chamber. The chamber temperature reaches 1800 degrees Fahrenheit. After a couple of hours, the cremated remains are carefully removed from the cremation chamber. The remains are then processed into a material called "cremated remains." Our cremation experts then place the cremains in a temporary container or an urn chosen and purchased by the family.

Cremation is uncomplicated.

Choosing cremation is perhaps the easiest way to ensure that your loved ones will not be faced with the burdens associated with a traditional funeral, such as selecting a casket and arranging for a viewing.

Cremation is affordable.

Because of the high overhead involved with the upkeep of funeral homes, traditional funerals often exceed \$7,500. What most people do not realize is that cremation costs are significantly less.

Direct cremation includes:

Transfer from anywhere in Pennsylvania; preparation of all documents; care, shelter and refrigeration of deceased; cardboard container, cremation process; filing of the death certificate; certified copy of the death certificate; assistance in placing obituary; and notification of Social Security and the Veterans Administration, where applicable.

10 Step Worry-Free Cremation Process

1. Commitment to A Code of Ethics. While your loved one is entrusted to our care, the staff at our funeral home adheres to a strict Cremation Code of Ethics providing an unmatched level of dignity, respect for your loved ones and peace of mind for our clients.

2. Protecting Personal Identity. To safeguard the security and identity of your loved one, an identification band is placed on your loved one as soon as they come into the care of the funeral home and a permanent stainless steel identification medallion with a one of a kind number is placed with them by the crematory staff.

3. Fingerprint Verification. A fingerprint of your loved one is also recorded and stored in their permanent case file and electronically. The family is able to request access to the fingerprint at any time.

4. Electronic Documentation. We offer electronic identification of you loved one prior to cremation to ensure your peace of mind.

5. Verification of Paperwork. All the cremation paperwork will be reviewed by a licensed funeral director and a CANA certified or industry certified technician to verify that all the necessary authorizations and permits have been obtained and properly documented.

6. Crematory That Met Our Standards. The experienced crematory that we have selected to use is the one that meets our high standards of care, follows strict operating policies and works side by side with us to ensure the process.

7. Cremation Control Book and Process. The crematory maintains a cremation control book. Upon taking your loved one to the crematory, the funeral director and crematory staff will record their name, identification number, date and time of cremation and the crematory operators name.

8. After the Cremation. Once the cremation is complete, the cremated remains along with the stainless steel identification medallion are processed and placed into the urn or any other container selected by the family. An identification card will also be kept in the crematory's records.

9. Transferring Remains. The funeral home will coordinate safe shipping of the cremated remains or arrange a time for pick up at our location.

10. Our Promise. Our staff is courteous and sympathetic; our facilities comfortable and spotless, our services are handled with warmth, dignity and respect. Our staff will assist with handling veterans and Social Security paperwork.
