Readings: Isaiah 35:4-7; James 2:1-5; Mark 7:31-37

<u>Baptism</u>: Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Marreddy.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of preparory meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week. <u>Confession</u>: This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Father Marreddy.
