From the Desk of Fr. Marreddy Pothireddy Readings: Genesis 18:1-10; Colossians 1:24-28; Luke 10:38-42

"Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

The sisters, Martha and Mary, mirror the two expressions of the disciple's call: loving service to others; prayer and contemplation.

Serving those in need and providing hospitality is considered an important Christian virtue. In general, welcoming a guest was and still is an extremely important obligation of people living in the Orient. Hospitality has been an important custom in several ethnic groups, in many parts of Asia, especially among Muslims and Jews. Hospitality is not only a holy responsibility but also a joyful opportunity to welcome and serve Jesus in the persons those who come to our tables.

Does the peace of Christ reign in our homes and in our personal lives? Jesus loved to visit the home of Martha and Mary and enjoyed their gracious hospitality. In this brief encounter we see two very different temperaments in Martha and Mary. Martha loved to serve, but in her anxious manner of waiting on Jesus, she caused unrest. Mary, in her simple and trusting manner, waited on Jesus by sitting attentively at his feet. She instinctively knew that what the Lord and Teacher most wanted at that moment was her attentive presence.

Anxiety and preoccupation keep us from listening and from giving the Lord our undivided attention. His grace frees us from needless concerns and preoccupation. Do we seek the Lord attentively? And does the Lord find a welcomed and honored place in our homes?

Scripture tells us that when Abraham opened his home and welcomed three unknown travelers, he welcomed the Lord who blessed him favorably for his gracious hospitality (Genesis 18:1-10; Hebrews 13:2). The Lord wants us to bring Him glory in the way we treat others and use the gifts He has graciously given to us. God, in turn, blesses us with His gracious presence and fills us with joy.



Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u>: Arrangements for infant baptism are made at least one month in advance. A one-hour Pre-Jordan session is required for parents who have not participated in one previously. Baptism is preferably celebrated during the Mass on Saturday or Sunday. To make arrangements, contact Fr. Marreddy.

<u>Marriage</u>: Arrangements for marriage should begin six months prior to the intended date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requires a series of meetings and a marriage encounter weekend. This sacrament is not celebrated during Lent or Holy Week.

<u>Confession</u>: This is offered before the Saturday Mass from 4:15 – 4:45 p.m., before or after daily Mass in the respective parishes or by appointment with Father Marreddy.
