Our Funeral Home "Professional Code of Conduct" which states we will interact with the families we serve in a compassionate, honest and responsible manner is the basis for our funeral home identification policy. This policy is for those families that choose a basic cremation service package or immediate burial.

You may choose an arrangement that allows for the physical identification of the deceased if it is possible.

A photo of the deceased will be presented to the next of kin when possible or a representative for identification. This identification must be signed by the next of kin of the deceased or the deceased families designated legal representative.

This signed statement is acknowledging absolute positive identification of the deceased by the identifying next of kin family member or the families designated legal representative.
