BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices, and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. The care and custody of the deceased prior to disposition and staff availability for personal details. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, real estate taxes, heating, lighting and maintenance of building and premises, necessary supplies (normal), and transfer equipment (specialized equipment used to handle and move dead human remains). This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (A portion of this fee is already included in our charges for immediate cremations, immediate burials, and forward or receiving remains.) \$ 3095.00

IMMEDIATE BURIAL (WITHOUT FUNERAL CEREMONY) \$ 4595.00 to \$ 25295.00

This charge includes basic services of funeral provider and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, transfer of remains to funeral chapel within a 30 mile radius, care of remains, and local transportation within a 30 mile radius to the place of final disposition.

This fee does not include embalming, visitation or funeral ceremonies, or other cemetery goods such as an outer burial container or grave opening and closing fees.

*Minnesota law does not require you to purchase an outer burial container, however, many cemeteries may require the use of such a container, so that the grave will not sink in.

IMMEDIATE CREMATION (WITHOUT FUNERAL CEREMONY)

\$ 3075.00 to 7210.00

This charge includes basic services of funeral provider and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, transfer of remains to funeral chapel within a 30 mile radius, care of remains, local transportation to the crematory, crematory charges, medical examiner cremation authorization fee, and temporary cremated remains container. This fee **does not** include embalming, coordination of cemetery arrangements, visitation or funeral ceremonies, or other goods such as a cremation urn.

Fee does not include gathering of obituary information, composing or placing of obituary notices, coordination with those providing other portions of a service, obtaining certified copies of the death certificate, or delivery of cremated remains.

"Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use an alternative cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation". The containers we provide are cardboard or wood.

There is not any law that requires a casket for direct cremation, or that a casket other than an unfinished wood box (alternative container) is required for direct disposition. However, Crematories and Cemeteries may require a minimum container.

PAYMENT POLICY

If the purchaser cannot or chooses not to make payment in full on or before the day of the funeral, a payment in the amount of \$_____ representing the estimated amount of one-half (1/2) of the total charges made by the funeral home must be paid to the funeral home on or before the day of the service. Payment in full of the balance due is required within TWENTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE AGREEMENT. We reserve the right to impose a 22% per annum unanticipated late payment penalty on any unpaid balance.

The following methods of payment are available for your convenience:

- **Pre-funded Funeral Arrangements**
- **Cash or checks** (third party checks are not acceptable).
- **Major credit cards** a 4% charge will be added to all Credit Card Transactions. (not eligible for prompt payment discount because of processing fees).
- **Assignable insurance:** once the assignability and beneficiary(s) have been verified, a notarized insurance assignment form has been signed by the beneficiary(s). Policies under two years of age are generally contestable, and may not be acceptable. *Note: We reserve the right to sell policies to third-party agencies for collection of insurance proceeds.*
- **Advance payment** by forwarding or receiving funeral home

We regret that we are unable to accept settlement of estates through attorneys or probate courts as a means of financial arrangements.
