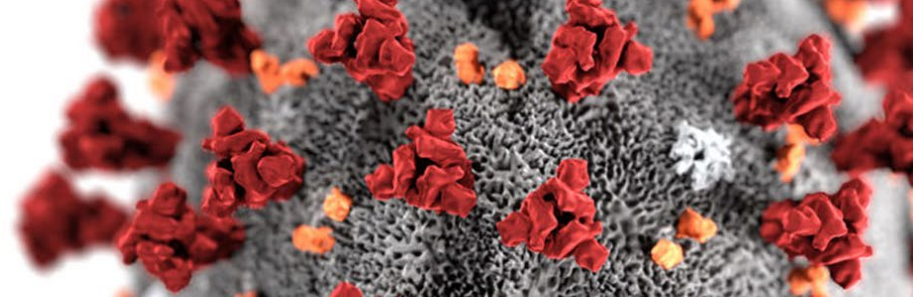


LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES
