GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of January 1, 2026

Information required by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC): *"The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected."*

SERVICE FEE OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF: \$4,500.00

Our charge includes funeral counseling, necessary arrangements, recording vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation of necessary notices, and coordination of service plans with parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased. Information required by the FTC: *"This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains."*

EMBALMING: \$990.00

This process provides short term preservation and restoration of a decedent's appearance and allows viewing to take place up to 4 weeks from the date of passing. Information required by the FTC: *"Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial."*

TRADITIONAL VIEWING + FUNERAL PACKAGE: \$7,200.00

Services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home within 20 miles, embalming and other preparations, use of the facilities for one or two days viewing, next day funeral ceremony at any location, casket coach, lead car, committal.

TRADITIONAL SAME DAY SERVICE PACKAGE: \$5,900.00

Services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home within 20 miles, embalming and other preparations, use of the facilities for viewing and same day funeral ceremony at any location, casket coach, lead car, committal.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL: \$3,800.00

Local transport and shelter of remains, basic services of staff, casket coach to local area cemetery, committal service. You may purchase one of our caskets or provide your own.

FORWARDING REMAINS: \$3,100.00

Local transport and shelter of remains, embalming, filing necessary documents and authorizations, and local transportation to airport.

Air Tray: \$295.00

Service Fee for International Shipping: \$985.00 (Includes shelter of remains for up to 6 weeks. \$250 per week thereafter.)

RECEIVING OF REMAINS: \$2,600.00

Transportation of remains from airport to cemetery, utility van, and basic services of funeral director and staff.

CREMATION

All packages include: transfer of remains from place of death and local transportation to crematory, necessary services of funeral director and staff, filing necessary documents and authorizations, and return of remains in a black plastic box. Information required by the FTC: *"If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide are heavy corrugated cardboard."*

GREEN BURIAL

These offerings allow for a funeral to take place with as little environmental impact as possible. Our Green Caskets and Shrouds are made from biodegradable materials. Body preparation suitable for a green funeral service consists of washing and setting features, and refrigeration or arterial embalming with non-toxic, non-formaldehyde fluids. Public visitations, church funerals, and graveside services are some of the options that may be arranged within the time frame that a green funeral allows.

WITH VISITATION, FUNERAL, AND GRAVESIDE SERVICE: \$5,500

Local transport from the place of death into our care; washing, dressing, casketing or shrouding; one day of viewing at our funeral home; funeral service at any location; graveside service; hearse and lead car for funeral procession.

WITH ONE HOUR VIEWING AND GRAVESIDE SERVICE: \$4,325

Local transport from place of death into our care, washing, dressing, and casketing or shrouding, one hour viewing immediately prior to leaving for the cemetery, and casket coach for graveside service at the appointed time.

WITH GRAVESIDE SERVICE: \$3,800

Local transport from place of death into our care, casketing or shrouding, and casket coach for graveside service at the appointed time.

PRICE GUARANTEE FOR A PRE-ARRANGEMENT: Add 15% to the Price

The Purchaser will be refunded or credited the difference of a package that has been fully pre-paid and guaranteed by paying this extra amount if on the day of delivery the price on the then current GPL for the same service is less than the purchaser previously paid.

PAYMENT POLICY: Payment in full is due at the time services are rendered. You may submit half at the arrangements conference and half upon completion of services. We accept cash, checks, money orders, credit/debit cards, transfers via Zelle, life insurance assignments, crowdfunding via our website, and pre-paid funeral plans.
