



COVID19 Policy

Due to the 2020 COVID19 “Corona Virus” outbreak we have implemented these new guidelines to protect our staff and the families that we serve. These guidelines are recommendations passed down to us by our available resources who are in contact with CDC every day, and are being implemented as a precautionary measure to not only keep everyone safe if we were to have a COVID19 case in our facility, but help stop the spread of this virus among the public.

COVID19 Policies

- *Funeral arrangements will be made over the phone, email, or video conference to the furthest extent possible. In-person conferences will be limited to as few people as possible. (Recommended “2”)*
- *No public visitations, funerals or memorial services will be scheduled.*
- *Families may have private viewings for immediate family members only.*
- *For funerals, we are recommending only private graveside services, again, limited to just immediate family members.*
- *Memorial services will be postponed until local restrictions are lifted.*
- *Private services may be recorded (Upon Request) for later viewing by family members and friends who weren't able to attend.*

Immediate Family Members are defined as: *Spouse, Children and Grandchildren.*

These groups will still need to observe social distancing guidelines in groups of 3 or less.
