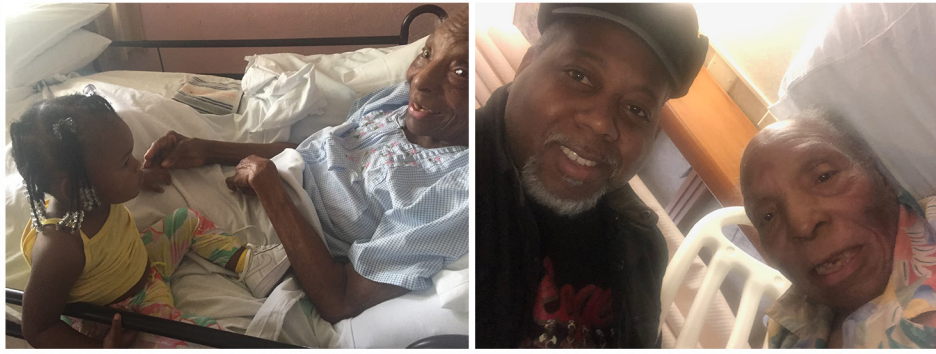

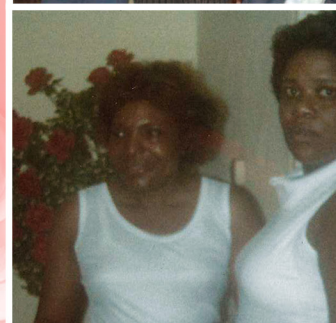
# Her Story

## A LIFE WELL LIVED
