Jasper Gore was born in Perry, Florida on January 12, 1926. He was the youngest of four children born to the union of Jasper and Annie Gore. He grew up in Miami, Florida and attended Dorsey High School.

In keeping with his desire to be of service, he entered the United States Army on March 25, 1944, receiving an Honorable Discharge in 1946. While in the Army, Jasper traveled to many parts of the world including China, Burma and India during WWII.
