A Time to be Born - The word of GOD tells us that all good and perfect gifts come from GOD, and on numerous occasions Lorraine reminded family, friends, and foes that she was perfect. On December 3, 1944, Benjamin James and Mary Jane Mobley (Both preceded her in death.) gave birth to LORRAINE MOBLEY in Miami, Florida. The perfect gift.

At an early age, she became a Christian and joined St. John Institutional Missionary Baptist Church in Miami, Florida. Lorraine's entire Christian life with the exception of the last decade was spent at St. John Missionary Baptist Church. The last decade of her Christian experience was spent at Peace Missionary Baptist Church, Miami, Florida, under the leadership of Rev. Tracy L. McCloud, D.Min.

A Time to Plant – Lorraine's elementary, secondary, and college experiences were garnered from Dunbar Elementary, Booker T. Washington Jr./Sr., Miami Northwestern Senior High, and Miami-Dade Community College. From her childhood in Overtown to her demise on October 7, 2020, Lorraine was known for her consistent SHARING of what she had with relatives, friends, and acquaintances. Hundreds of individuals in Miami-Dade County, surrounding counties, states, and countries have tangible evidence of her constant giving. For example, the lovely custom made handkerchiefs she gave to individuals on special occasions. If Lorraine knew you or your loved one, she was always ready to "GIVE" of her services.

A Time to Love – On December 3, 1964, her birthday, she married the love of her life the "KING," Roman King (preceded her in death). From that union Roman, Jr. was born. Hence "The Three Kings". Roman King, Sr., Lorraine M. King, and Roman King, Jr.

A Time to Build - In February of 1969 Lorraine joined the Eastern Airlines family. She was consistently recognized by Eastern Airlines and customers for the exceptional service she rendered to the thousands of customers she came in contact with on a daily basis. Then came the day, March 9, 1989, when Eastern Airlines, was grounded forever. After her employment at Eastern airlines, Lorraine worked for St John Institutional Missionary Baptist Church, Miami, Florida; Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Florida Department of Children and Families for a number of years.

A Time of Peace - God's chariot swung low before sunrise on October 7, 2020, to carry Lorraine M. King peacefully home to be with her Heavenly Father and to join her loving, earthly husband, Roman King, Sr.; her parents, Benjamin James and Mary Jane Mobley; her sister, Shirley Mobley; her brother, Charles Lamar Mobley; and her daughter, Virginia Patterson. Her memory will be cherished by her sons, Rev. G. Christopher Clark (Yvette), Roman, Jr. (Donna); her daughters, Kawannah Griffin (Chris), Donna Williams, Cassandra Davis (Ira).
