Mattie's Life Story

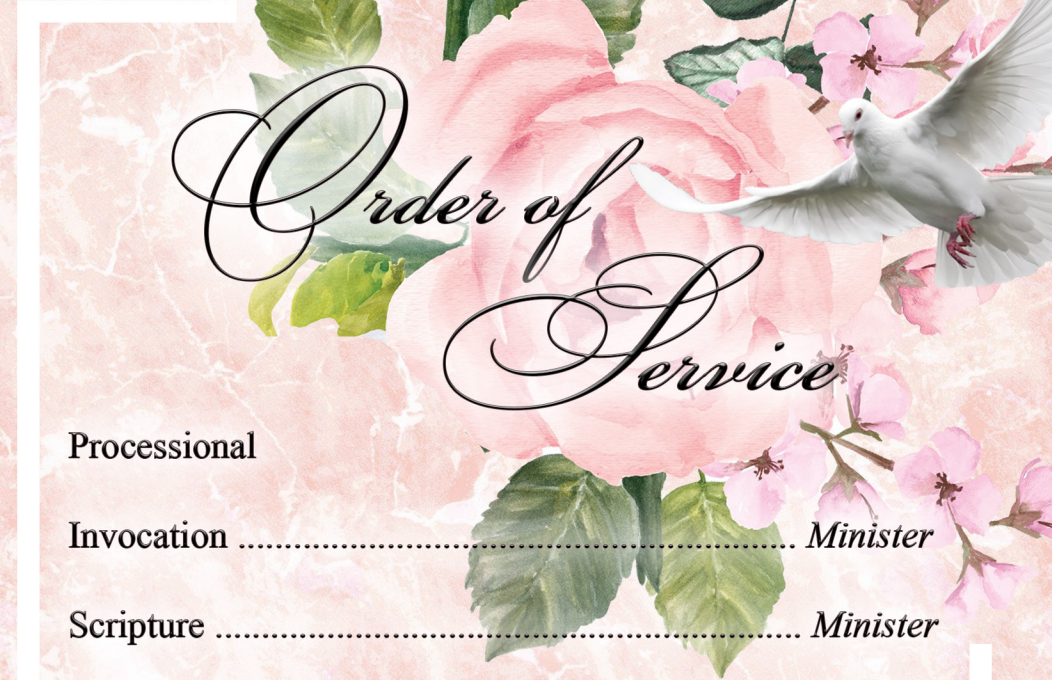
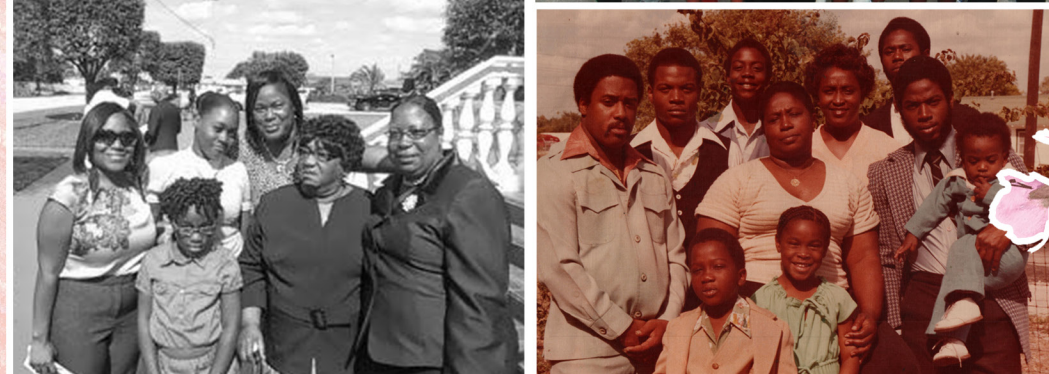
