## Dr. Marityn, Jeannene Thompson

On October 12, 1943, the heavens rejoiced, and the earth smiled as it welcomed a baby girl named Marilyn Jeannene Frierson. She was the second born daughter of the union between her parents, the late William Theophilus Frierson and Mae Vesta Battle Frierson in Waycross, Georgia.

Dr. Thompson attended Booker T. Washington Senior High School and graduated in 1959 at the age of 16. She graduated from St. Thomas University (previously named Biscayne College), where she received her Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Social Work. She continued her education and received her Doctoral of Theology in Biblical Studies from Jacksonville Theological Seminary.

Dr. Thompson's great love and desire to help others is why she always gained employment in the areas that enhanced the quality of life for God's people. She left her mark throughout her career within Miami Dade County Public Schools, the State of Florida, and Miami Dade County.

In 1981, Dr. Thompson gave her life to Christ. She joined Believer Life Ministries, and later moved her membership to Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church on April 22, 2007, where she was a faithful and dedicated member. Dr. Thompson was a true disciple of Christ and preached the pure words of truth. She was a woman of great faith, persistence, and power.
