No more "maybe-maybe-not"

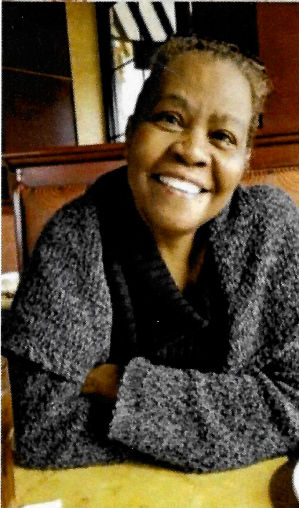

This marriage lasted over 15 years and ended after Van's failing health eventually took his life.

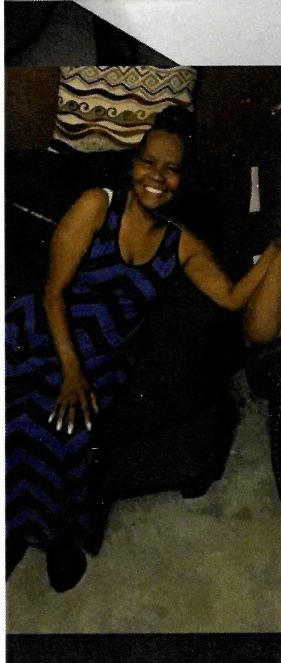
Dorothy would later have another chance at motherhood by adopting her 2 paternal grandchildren as her own (Zariontre and Vanessa McCoy)

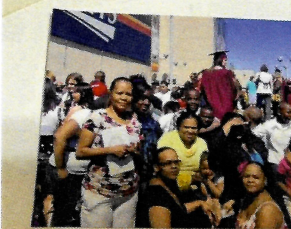
