Reflections of His Life

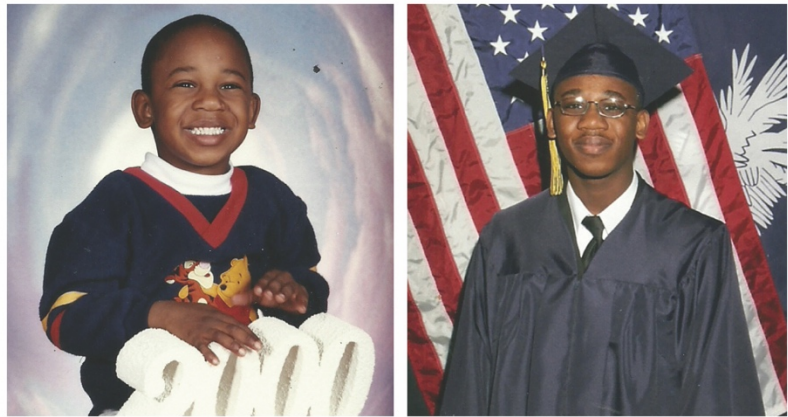
