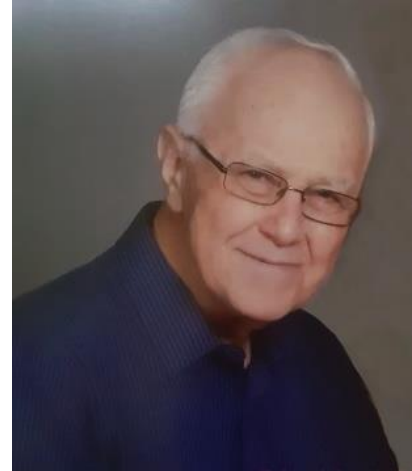


Henry F. Opicka
