## Obituary

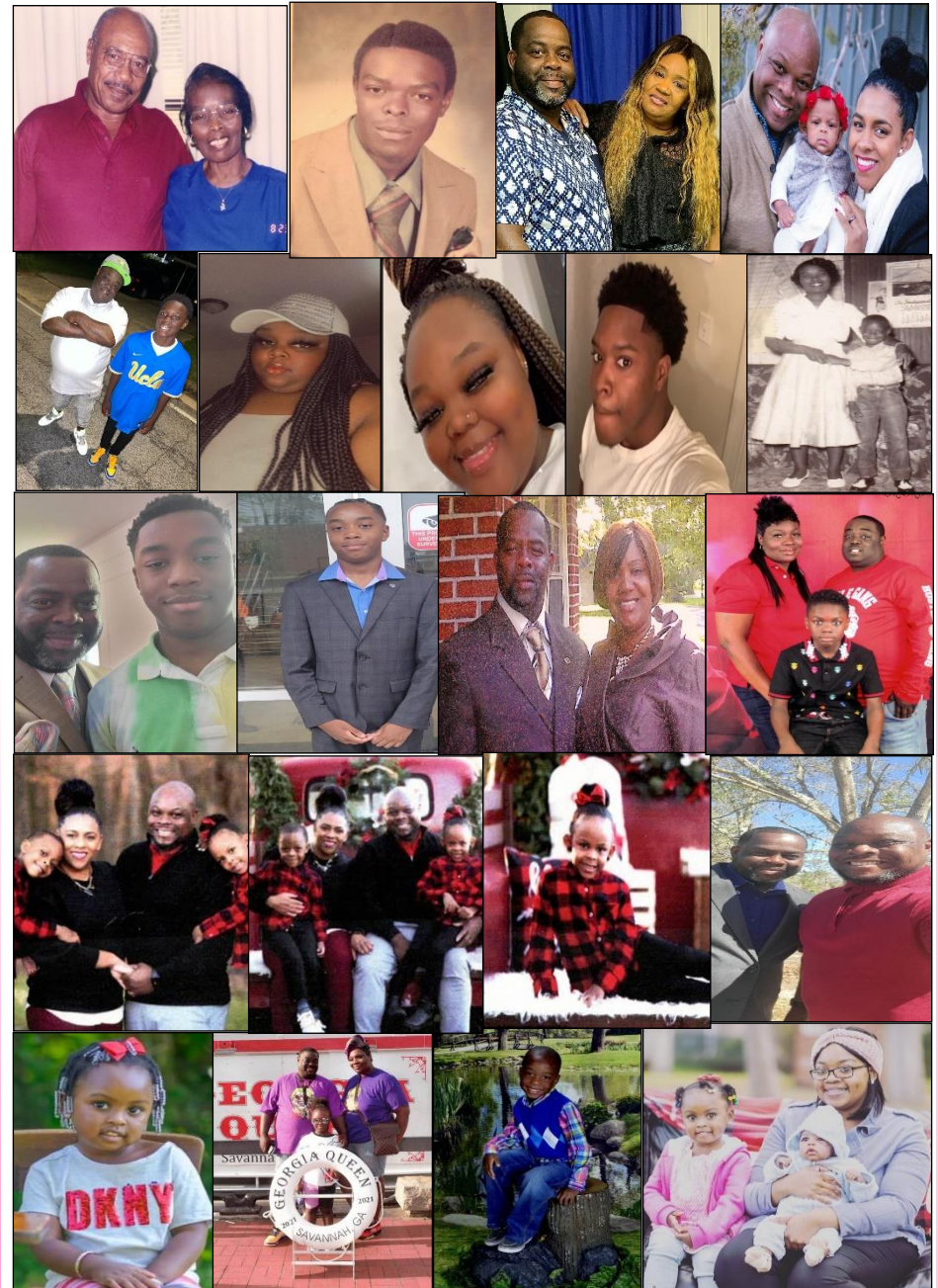
