Obituary


Gerald Arthur Scheidt died Saturday, October 30, 2021 in Sandy Springs Georgia. He was a long time resident of Dunwoody, GA. He was born October 5, 1923 in Buffalo New York. Gerald attended the University of Buffalo, on the GI Bill, after serving in the Army Air Corp. in WWII. He graduated with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. He was married to Bernice Ferguson on July 12, 1952. He was a devoted husband and father, and enjoyed traveling with his wife after retirement.

He spent the bulk of his career working as a Senior Development Engineer for Western Electric/AT&T/ Lucent Technology until his retirement in 1987. He was a gifted engineer and inventor. He was awarded two patents for his design of cable telecommunication equipment. He was a proud veteran who never tired of talking about his experiences working on P47 fighter planes in the war.
