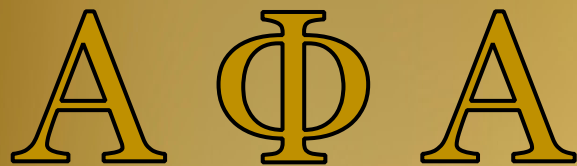
Harold Dean Foster, Sr. was born July 15, 1943 to Ulysses and Allie B. Foster in Marshall, Texas.
