
Don't Cry For Me

Mrs. Geraldine Alice Tillage Bain was born the fourth of eight children on August 16, 1942 in Wake County, North Carolina to the late Ivory Tillage and Ethel Mae Tillage. God called her home on Sunday, June 12, 2022.

Geraldine was a Christian, loving wife and dedicated mother, grandmother, sister and aunt amongst other titles that she held within her family.

She grew up in the Fuquay-Varina area and at an early age, she confessed her life to Christ and joined New Providence Missionary Baptist Church along with her mother, Ethel Mae, who was the first and only female Deacon of the church.

Sixty-three years ago, on December 24, 1959, Geraldine married David Alfred Bain, Sr. in Fuquay-Varina, NC. She was devoted to her husband and children and to this union was born, her sons, David Bain, Jr. (Clara), Omar Sharif Bain, Leon Bain (deceased); four daughters, Jacqueling Bain (Lawrence), Jessica Bain (Santiago), Gina Bain Rodriguez (Arnaldo) and Subriana Johnson (Mickey).

She took pride in being a homemaker. Among other things, she was a babysitter and excellent cook and often replied, "my babysitting days are over with!" One of her favorite past times was fishing. She received her education at Fuquay Consolidated School. She was full of wisdom and taught those she loved life's lessons that she lived by, she learned from and she generously shared.

For those who remembered Geraldine, she was known for her great sense of humor, her sense of style, her way with words and the way she expressed her feelings. She was a mother who was never lacking in discipline but was always fair. She was a woman who sacrificed by putting her children before her own needs. She also pushed her children to never settle for anything less than their worth.
