



A much-loved mother, grandmother, and sister, Minh-Chau T. Vu, passed away peacefully in Chicago, Illinois, on November 3rd, 2021.

She was born in Mong Cai, Quang Ninh, Vietnam on December 25th, 1938. In 1954, she was one of the southward immigrants who settled down in Saigon. A few years later, she married Duoc Hoang Luu. They had four children together: Trung Vu Luu, Truong Vu Luu, Minh-Trang Vu Luu and Minh-Chi Vu Luu. They grew their family in My Tho, Dinh Tuong, Vietnam through the 1960s, then came the end of the Vietnam War. After the war, Trung and Minh-Trang escaped to the United States. In 1992, the family reunited in Chicago, Illinois.

The family added Andy Bui in 1992 as a son-in-law, and Annie Nguyen and Huong Mai in 1995 as daughters-in-law. The grandchildren then came, Vi-Vien Trang Bui in 1995, Thao-Vien Trang Bui and An Mai Luu in 1999, Dat Hoang Luu in 2000, and Tam Mai Luu in 2002.

Her children and grandchildren remember her fondly for her unconditional love and gentle nature. She will be missed.
