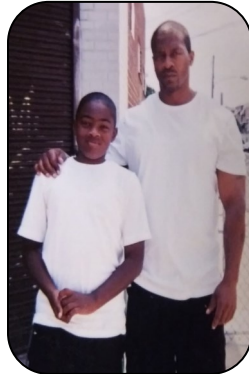
My Letter to my Family

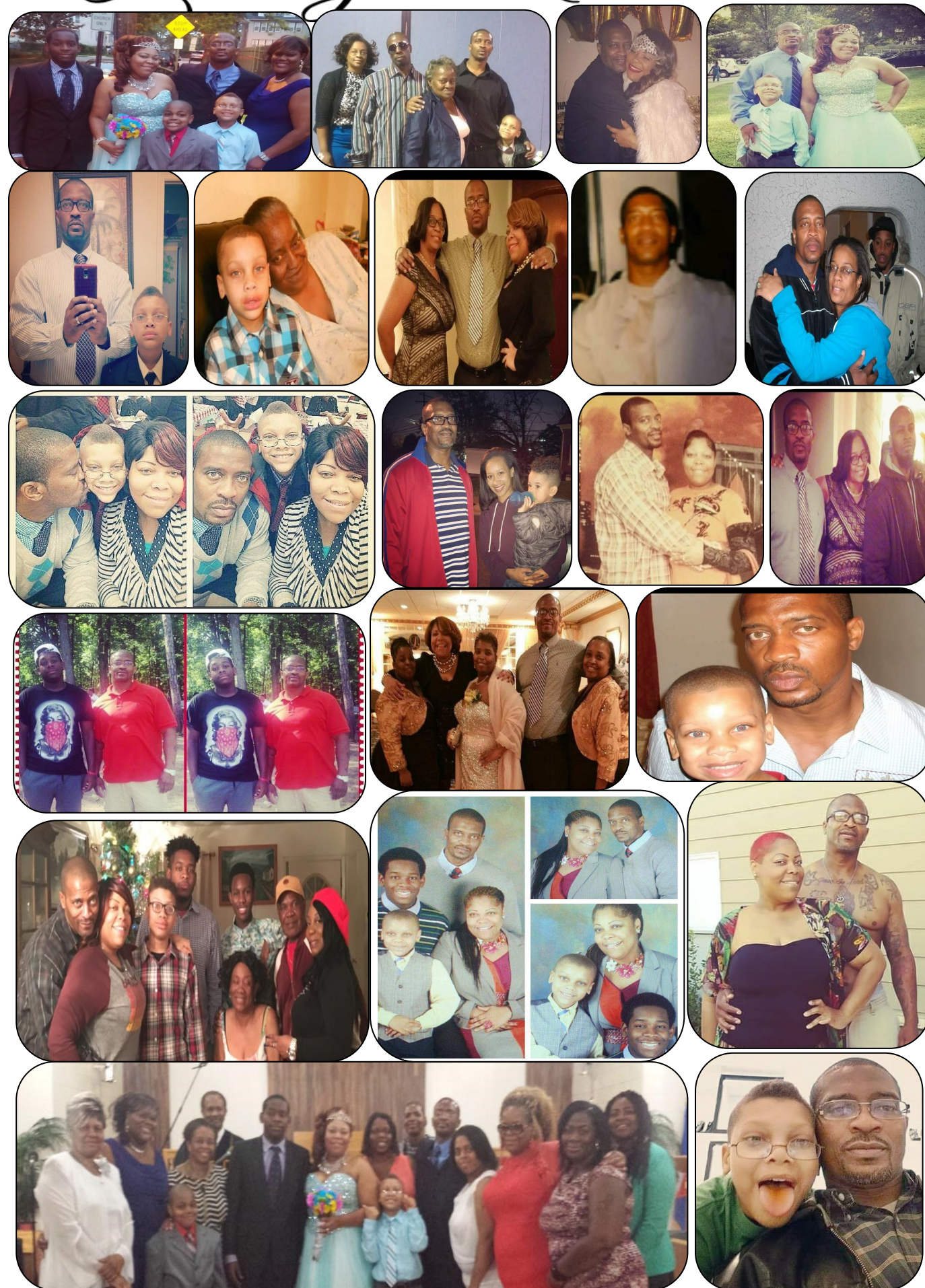

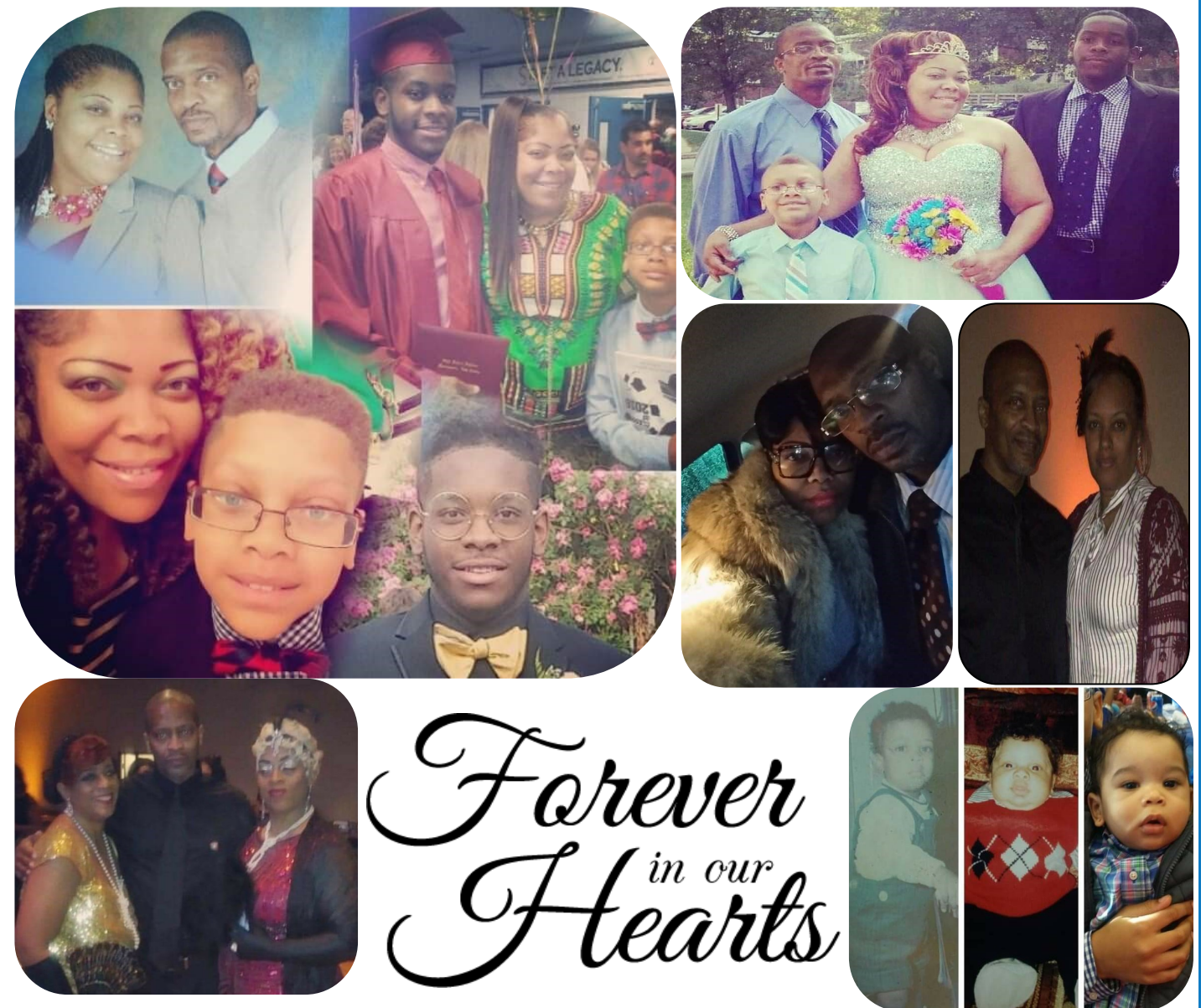


A Loving Tribute
