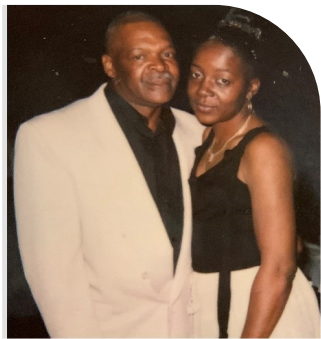

He moved to Camden in the 70's. In the early 80's he met Jacqueline Plowden and soon fell in love. They flourished, had children, were married and blended families.

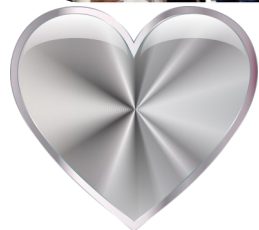
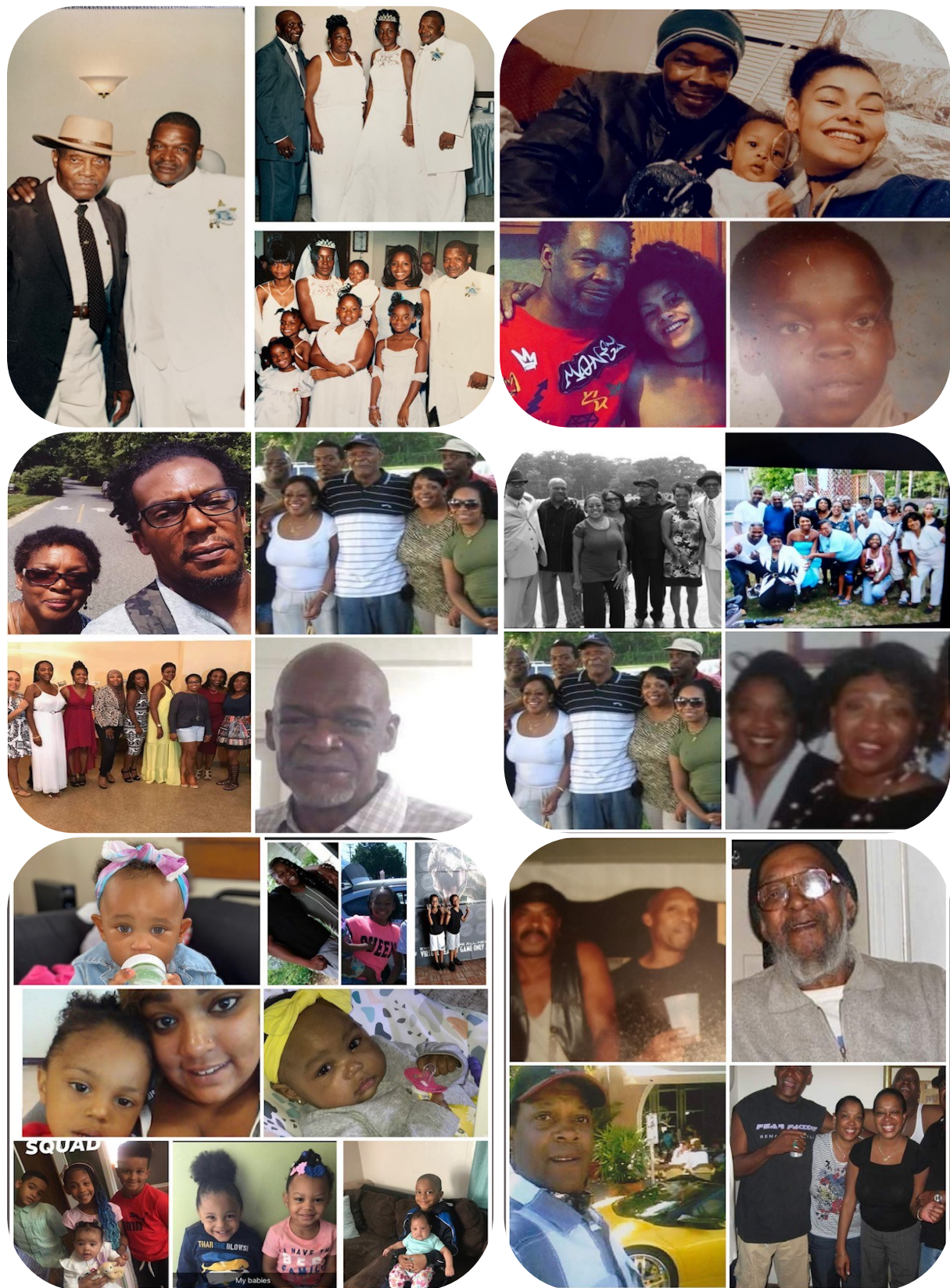
