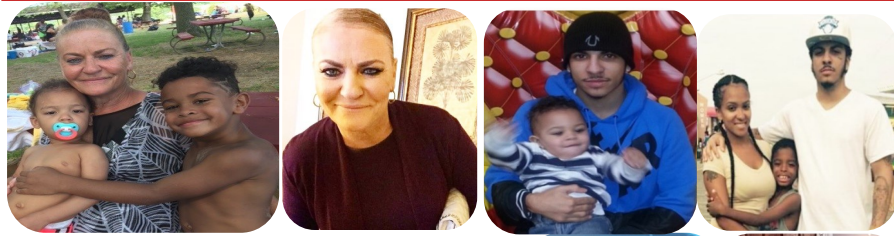

**He** aspired to move into a house with all of his children and to marry the love of his life.

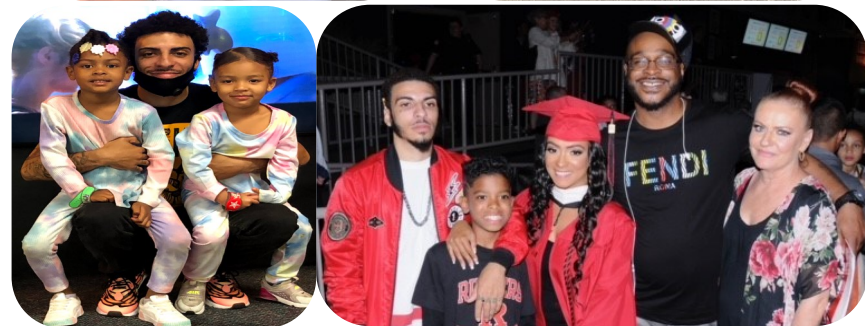
**He** Aspired to be a Marine Biologist
