Obituary

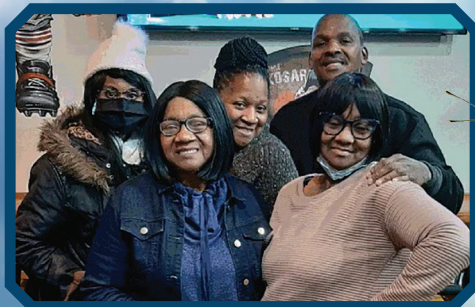
On Friday, January 7, 2022, **MINA M. BENN** was called from labor to reward at age 82. She was known for her infectious smile, her love for the Lord, and for telling others about Jesus Christ. She sometimes ended a call with Peace and Blessings and made sure you knew the Lord would make a way.

Mina was born on December 6, 1939, in Cleveland, Ohio, to Mr. and Mrs. Julius C. Levert, Sr., and Rosie B. As a child she lived on Orange Avenue, when it was a residential area. She attended East Tech High School and left there to work at the local Chicken House. Mina worked at Montefiore Nursing Home on Cedar Avenue, and from there she went on to do private duty care. Mina was the fourth of nine children born to her parents. Her siblings were Chester Levert, Queen Rodgers (John), Charles Levert, Sr., Raymond Levert, Julius C. Levert, Jr. (Laura), Alfred Levert, Mary Ann Carter (Ron), and Richard Levert, Sr. (Barbra).

Mina was married to John Henry Benn, whom she met at East Tech on November 16, 1963. From that union they had four children, Marietta Dawson (George), Jacob David Benn, Yolanda Benn, and Rose McClenton (Tommy). They gained four grandchildren, Shcarra Benn, Laprise Johnson, De'Juana Chambers, and Elijah Flint.

She gave her life to Christ at an early age at Zion Hill Church, where she attended with her family. They also attended New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church. For the past 25 or more years she was under the Pastoral Care of Reverend Ercell J. Goodman and his wife, Bernette. She joined New Beginnings Missionary Baptist Church and ended her services under Springfield Missionary Baptist Church. In her devotion to Christ she became an Evangelist. She was a mother in the church, a nurse, and an usher. She taught Sunday school and was in the choir. Mina helped others in many ways as the Lord led her.
