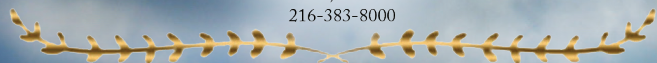

JOYCE ANN BURGE was born November 3, 1951, in Birmingham, Alabama, but later moved to Cleveland, Ohio.

Joyce Burge attended John Hay High School, and shortly after graduating, she dedicated her life to Christ as a member of the Original Church of God Temple of Deliverance, under the leadership of her mentor, the late Pastor Narbell Sweet.

Joyce Burge loved doing crafts. Her favorite store was Hobby Lobby, but most of all, she was an outstanding ambassador of Christ. A Bible scholar she was. One of her favorite quotes was, "Don't miss Heaven." She loved everything about church.

Right now, she would say, "My feet are in the right place."

In 1993, Joyce Ann Burge united in marriage with Pastor Alvin White of the Original Church of God in Richmond, Indiana. They were married for 13 years. Upon his death in 2006, she was ordained as Pastor Joyce White. She served as pastor for four years and later relocated back to Cleveland, Ohio.

Pastor Joyce White, who was also known as Teacher White by Pastor Williams, went home to be with the Lord on March 30, 2022.
