# Loistene Scott

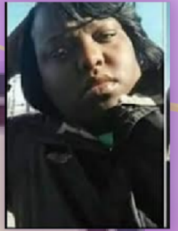

I could almost hear her say

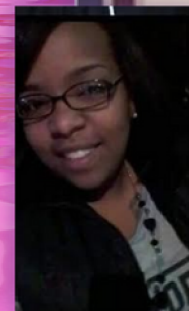
"Dear grandchild- I will miss you
