Obituary

Cameron Elijah Cole was born on October 29, 2022, to Charles Cole and Britney Churchwell in Cleveland Ohio at Fairview Hospital. Cameron was born at 36 weeks due to complications from his mother's pregnancy related to a fall at work. As a result of the accident, he was diagnosed with severe brain injury from lack of oxygen.

Cameron was a daily testament to how strong he was in his day-to-day life. Cameron fought for 7 long hard months, despite what the doctors said about his grim diagnosis. Cameron's mom and dad were by his side day in and day out. He spent 198 days at Cleveland Clinic Neonatal Intensive care unit (NICU) at the Cleveland Clinic Main Campus. His wonderful team of nurses Rachel, Kathleen, and Francine and a host of others took great care of our guy! Cameron left to rehab in hopes of coming home May 15th only 4 short days before he returned to the hospital 1 last time.

217 days we were blessed with Mommy's FAT daddy man but sadly on June 3, 2023, he and God decided to end the fight together. Cameron is the sixth son to Britney, and Charles third biological son. Cameron Elijah Cole is preceded in death by his older brother D'marre Ramier Chambers, Great grandmothers Donna Jones, Michelle Lane, and Laquita Wise. His great great grandmother Dora Lane.

For such a mother's love.

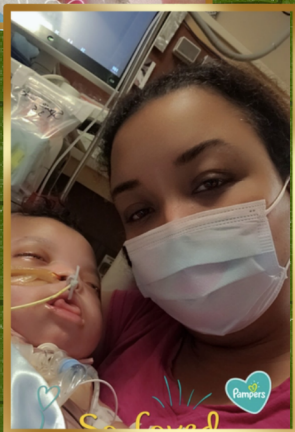
The divine love he brought with him,
