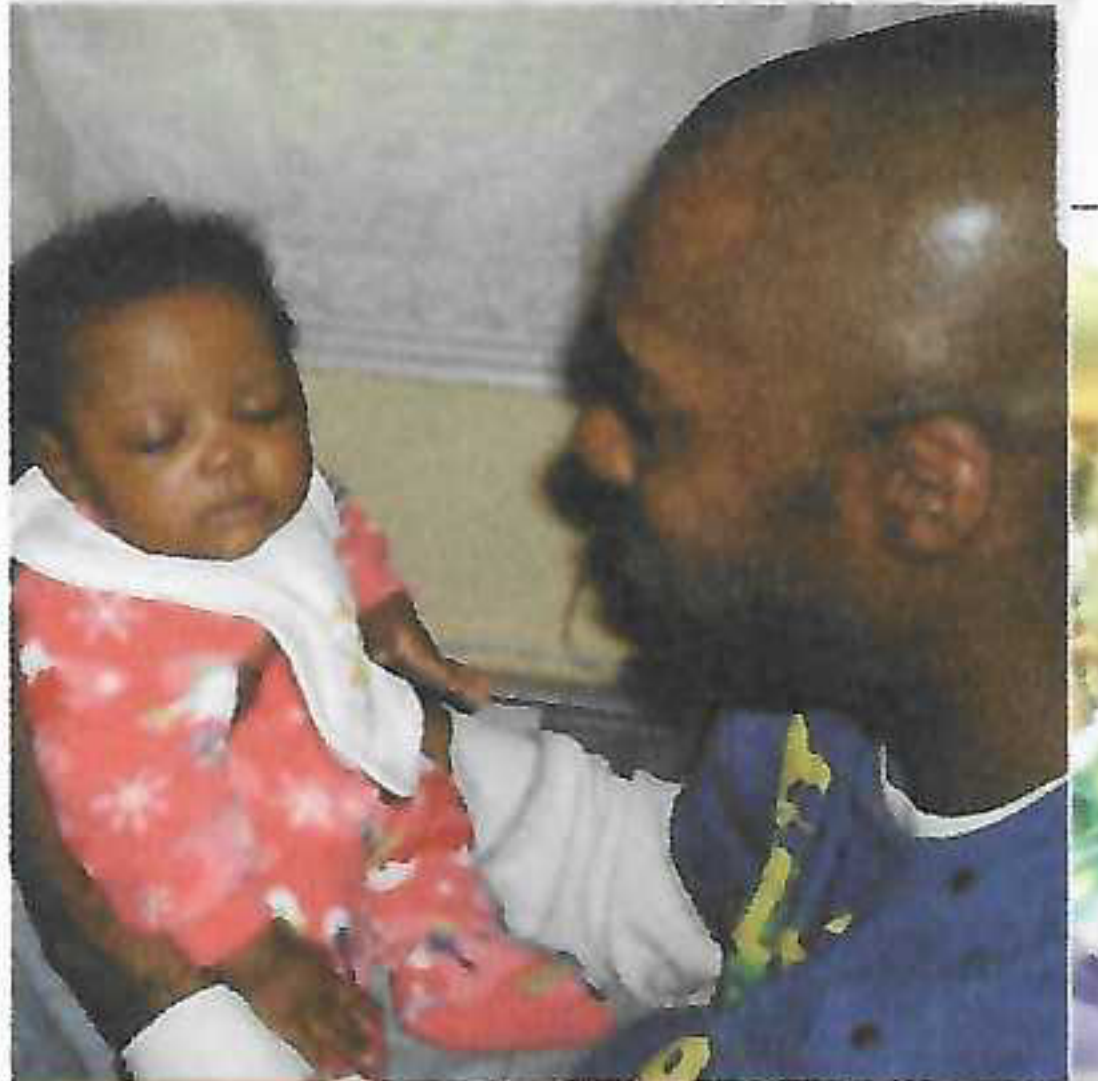
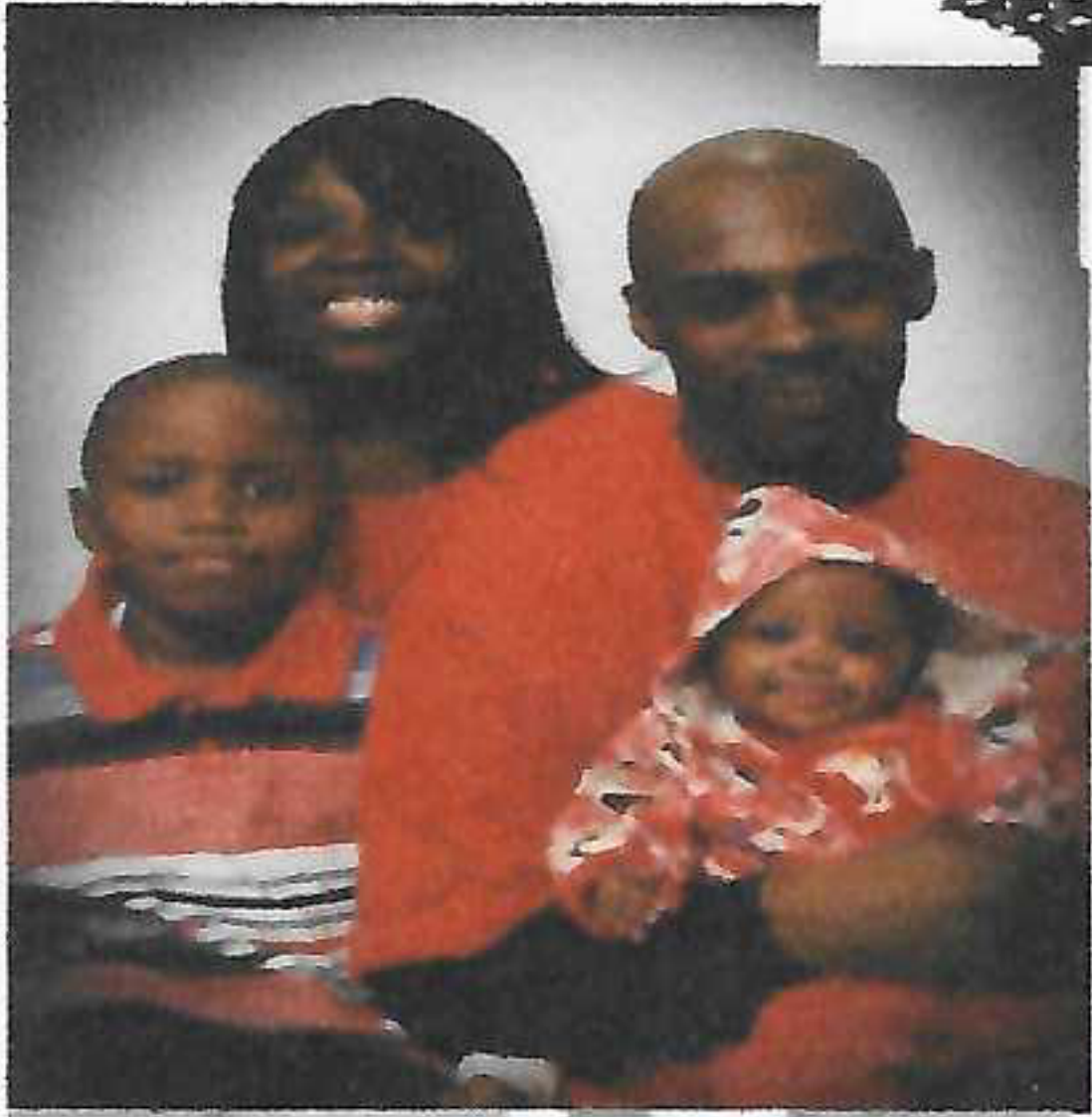
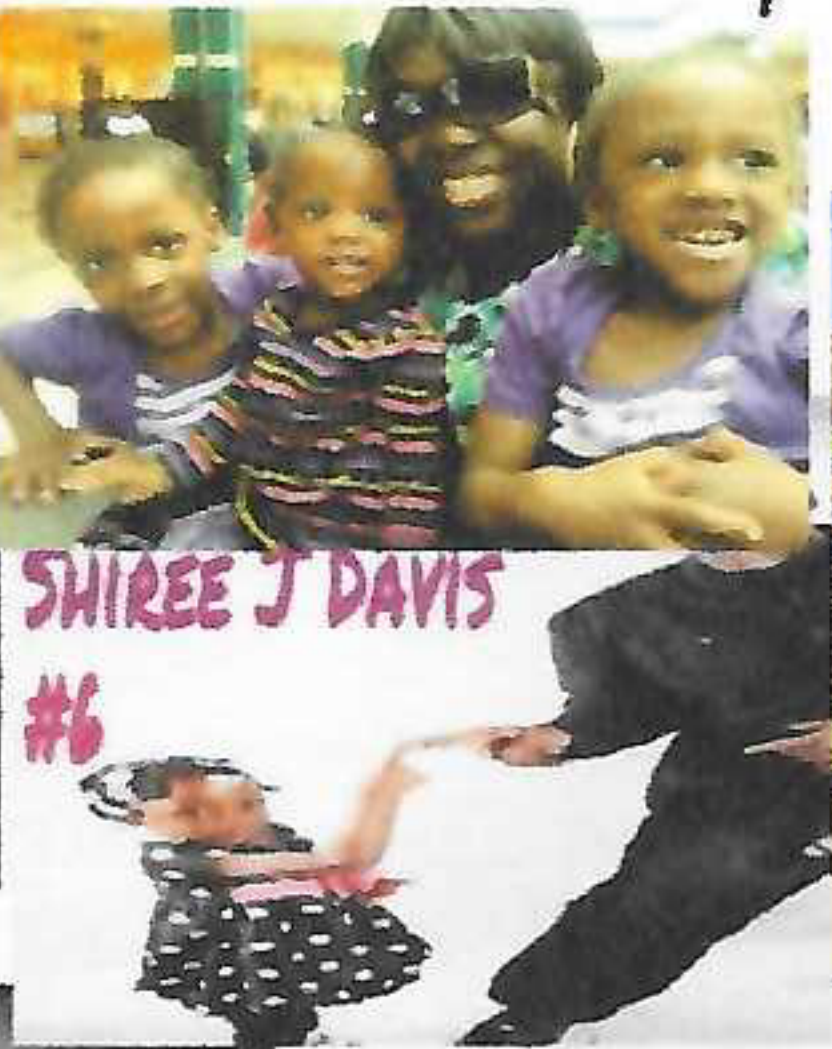
Obituary

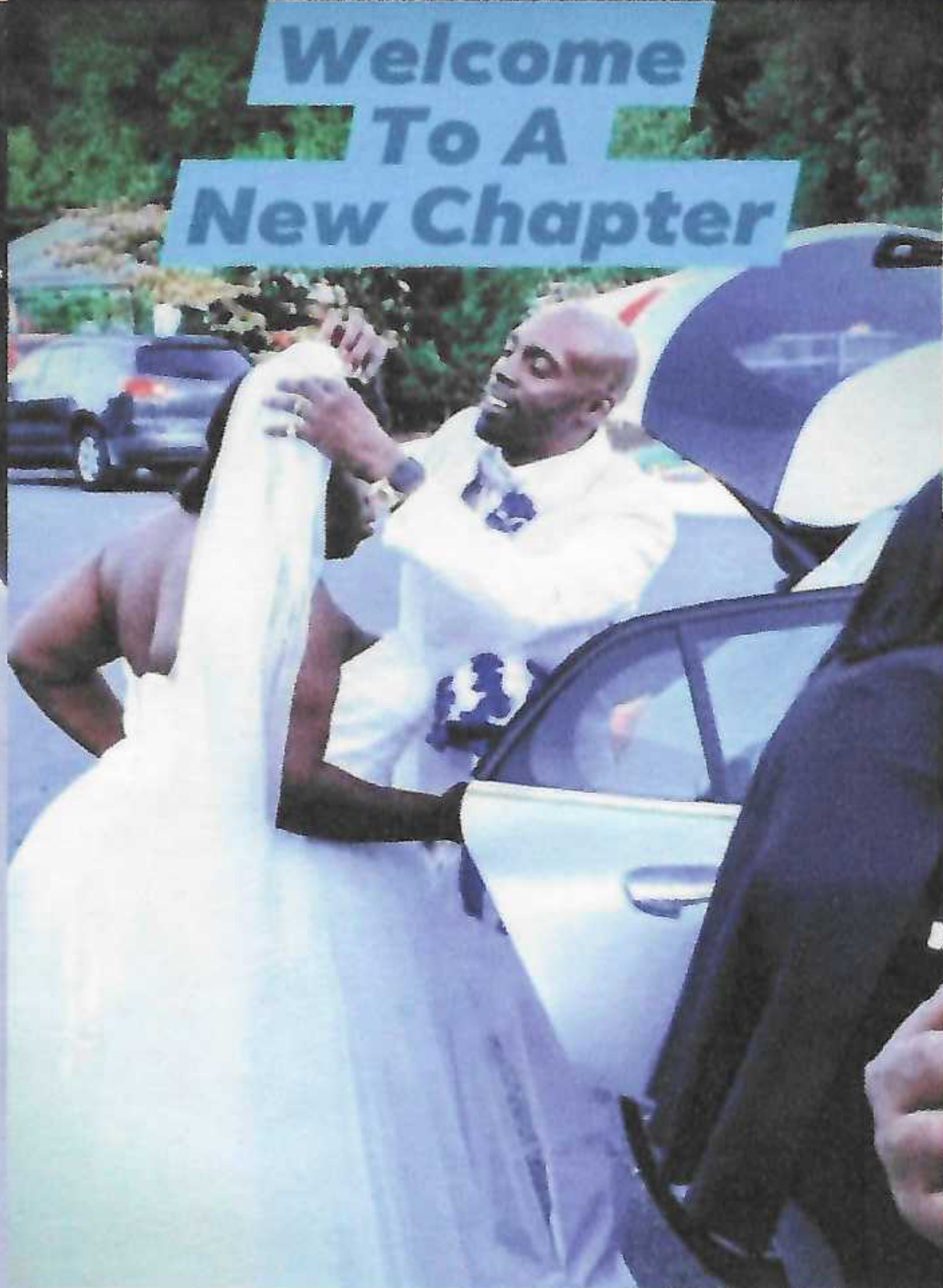

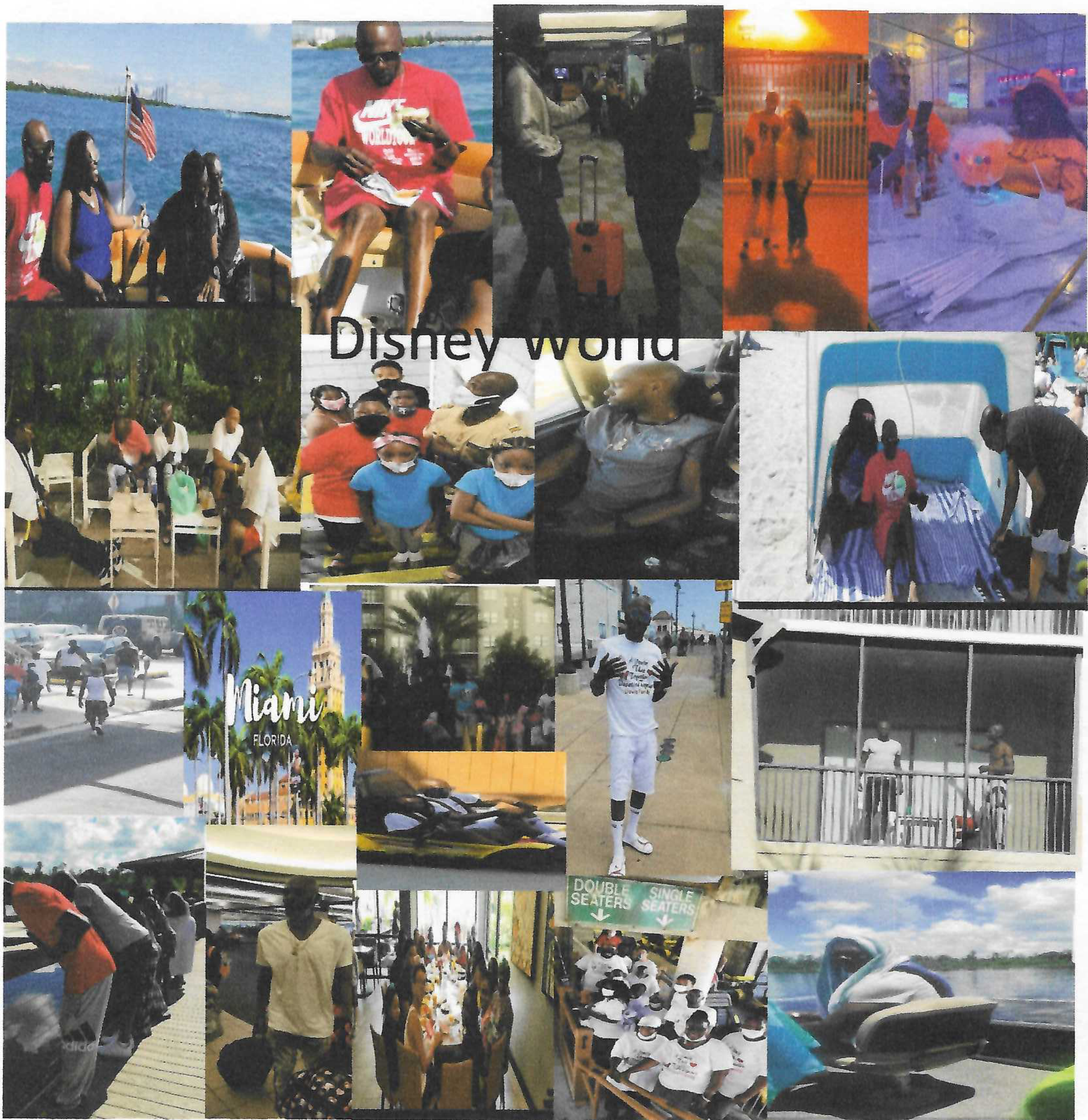

The Moment that you left me,

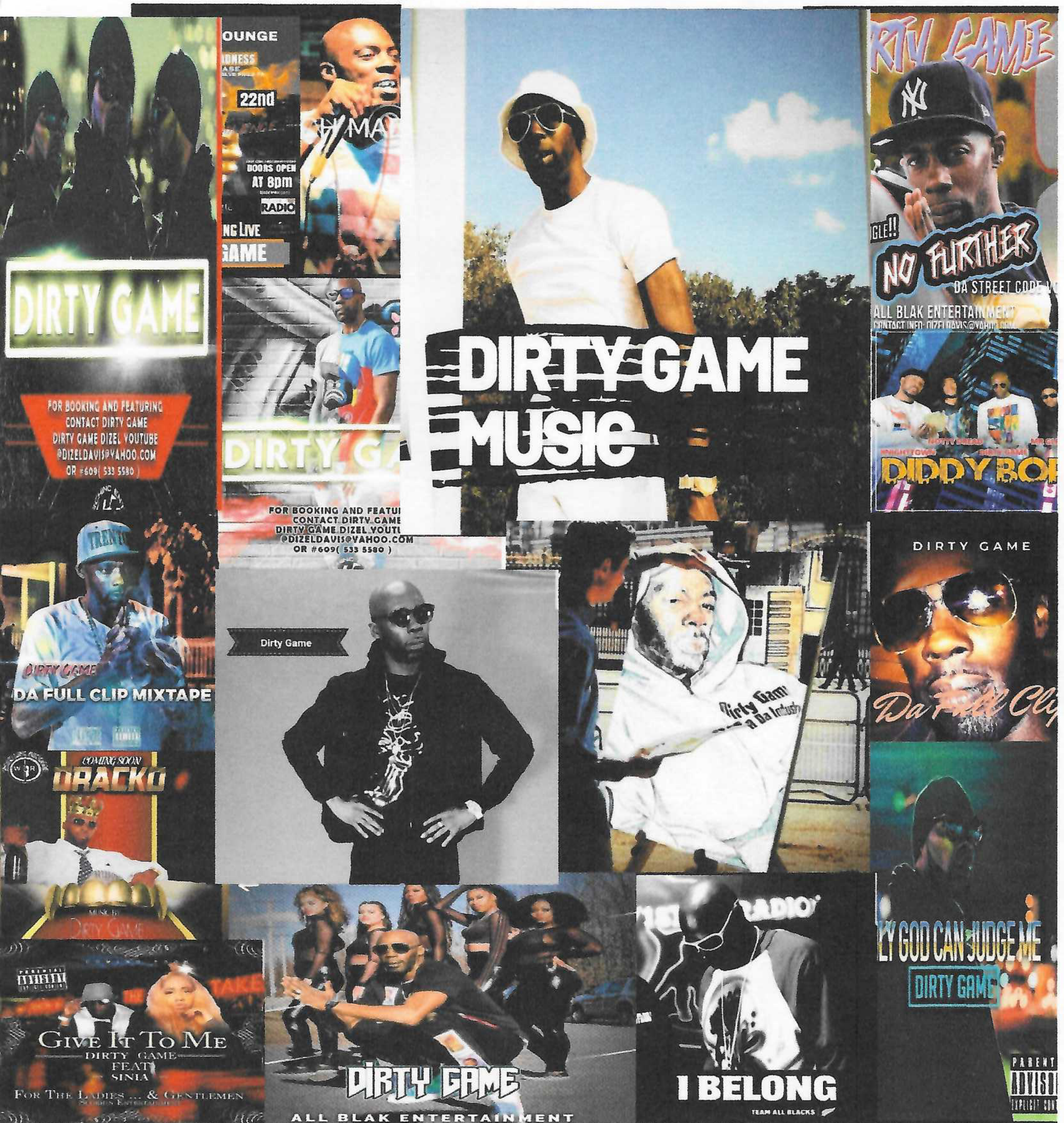
*my heart split in two. One side filled
