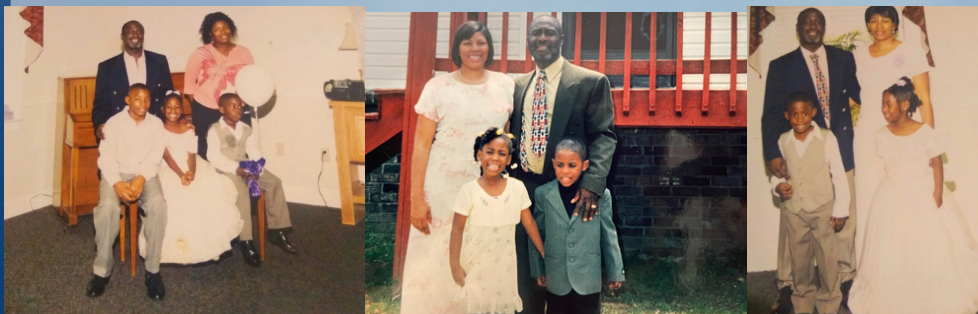


Obituary
