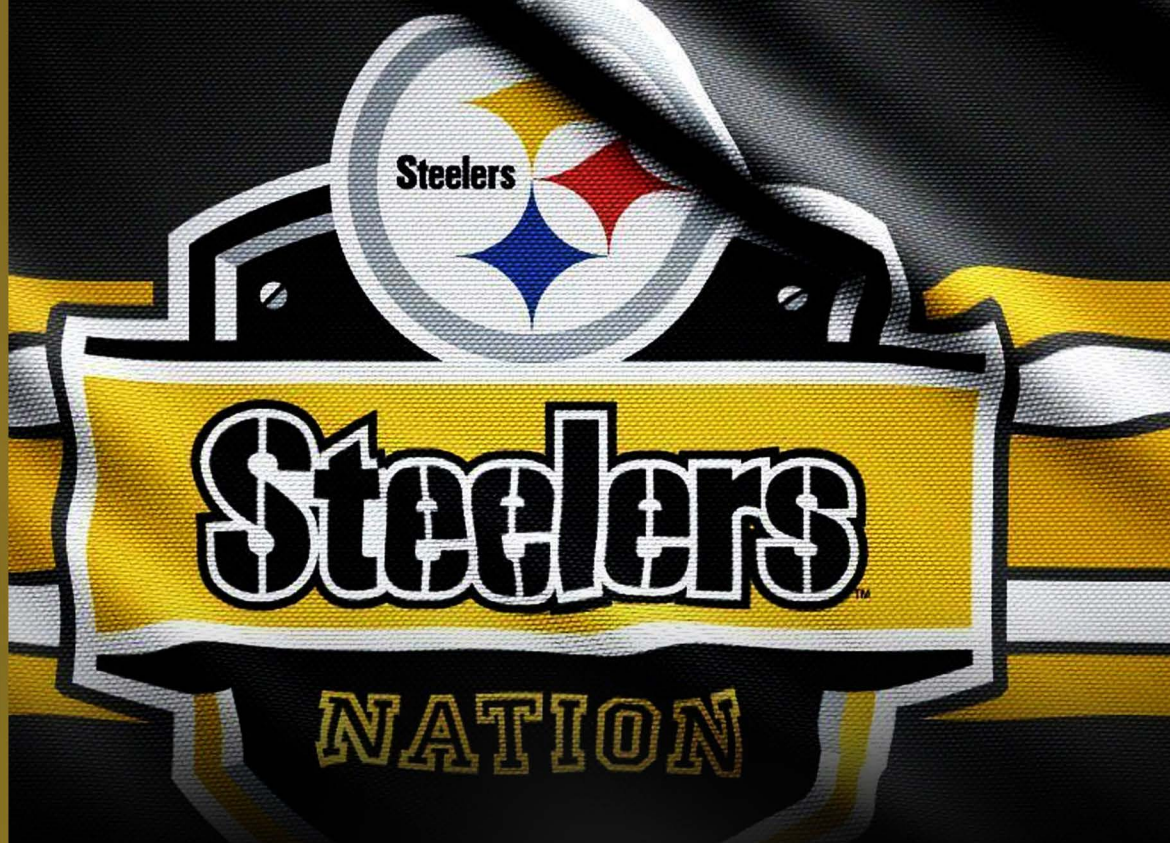


DEAR DESMOND,

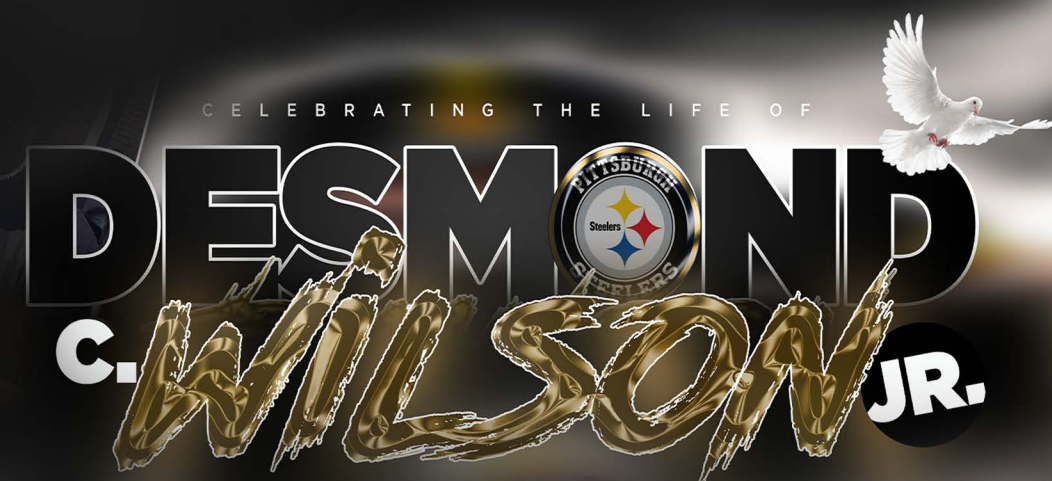

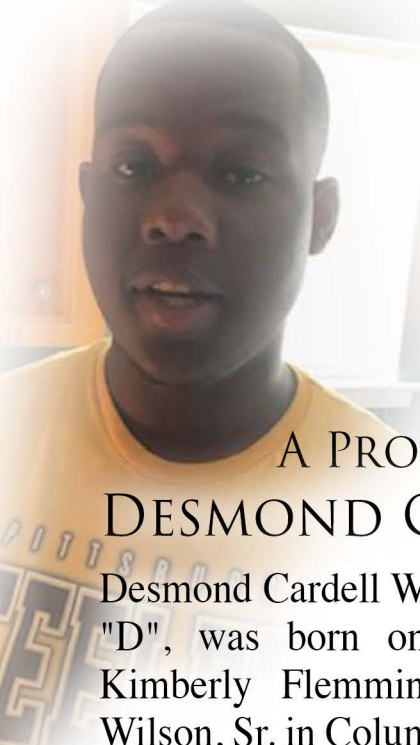
