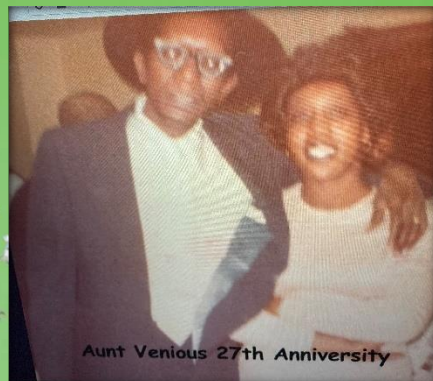

January 28,1943 – April 29, 2022

Our dearest Gloris “Gloria” Brunson transitioned from this life to rest in the eternal arms of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ at Isabella Center for Rehabilitation on April 29, 2022, at 79 years old.
