Obituary of Deacon Romeo Felder

Deacon Romeo Felder was born April 4, 1944, in Bowman, South Carolina to Wesley and Catherine Gaines Felder. He was called home to eternal rest, Sunday afternoon, October 9, 2022.

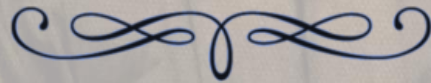
Romeo was educated in the public schools of Bowman, South Carolina and received his high school diploma from Bethune Memorial High School. He met and married the late Barbara Ann Jones and to that union one daughter was born, Romanda Felder. The family moved from Bowman to Philadelphia, PA where he was employed with Penn Packing, then with Philadelphia Board of Education until his retirement. Romeo joined the Second Mt. Zion Baptist Church and was ordained as a deacon in the ministry and served as a trustee. He was also a member of Keystone Grand Lodge A.F. & A.M. (Scottish Rite Affil.) of the State of Pennsylvania, Inc.

Romeo was a firm believer in family and looked forward to gatherings including the Annual Shady Grove Camp Meeting. He loved cars, trucks, tractors, his lawnmower, and fur babies (TiTi, Princess, and Sasha).

On November 4, 1995, Romeo was united in holy matrimony to Audrey Campbell who faithfully loved and cared for him even in sickness.
