Barbara was known to many as "Big Sister" or "Aunt Biggie". She had a strong faith in God and was well known and loved by many.

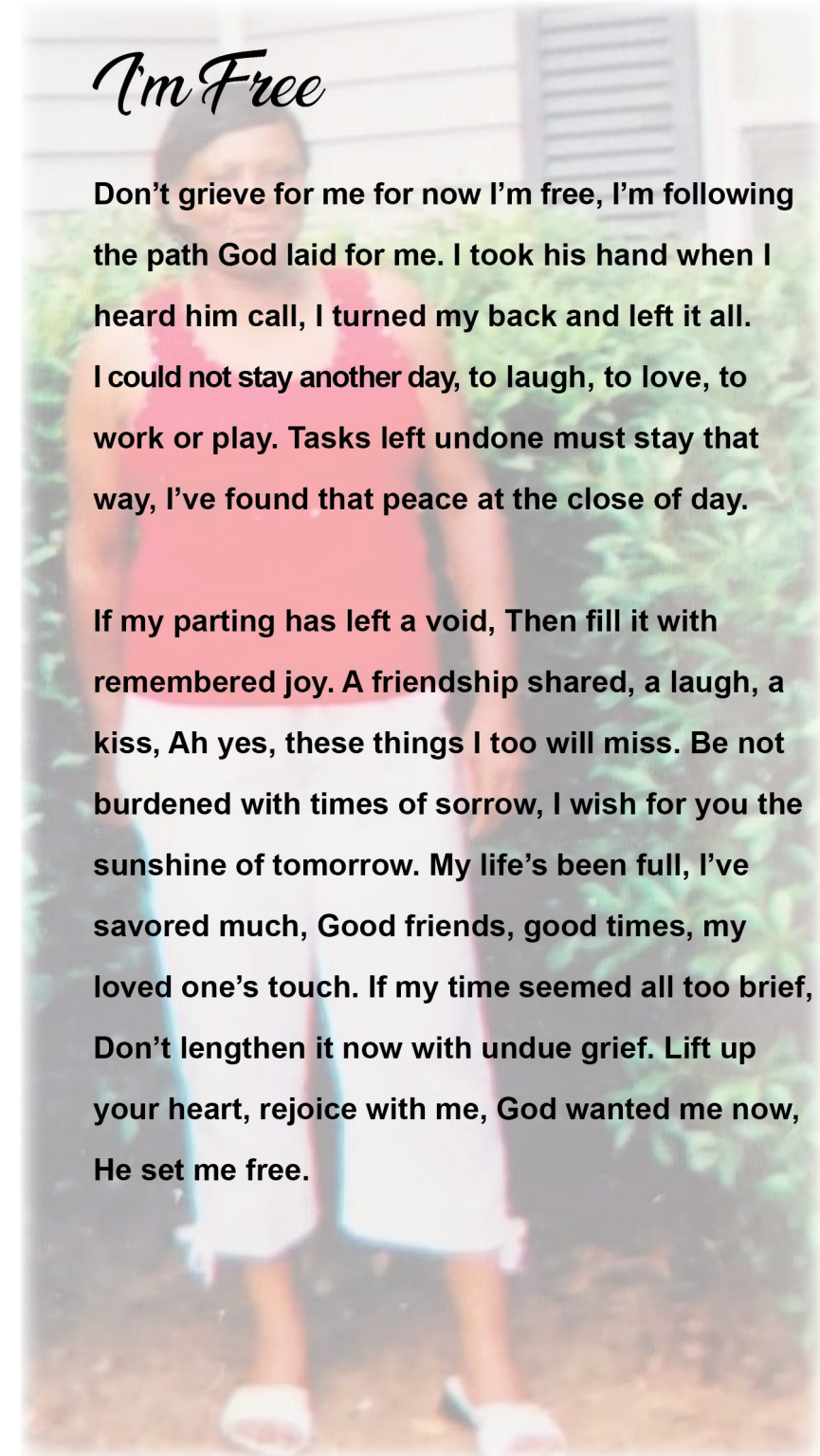
