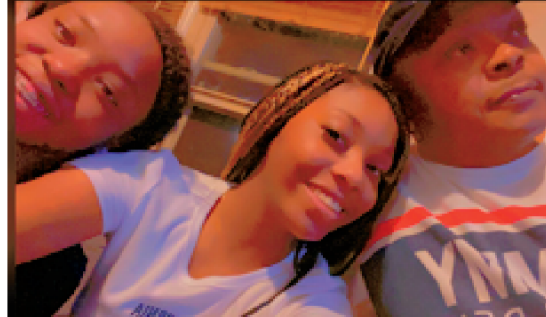
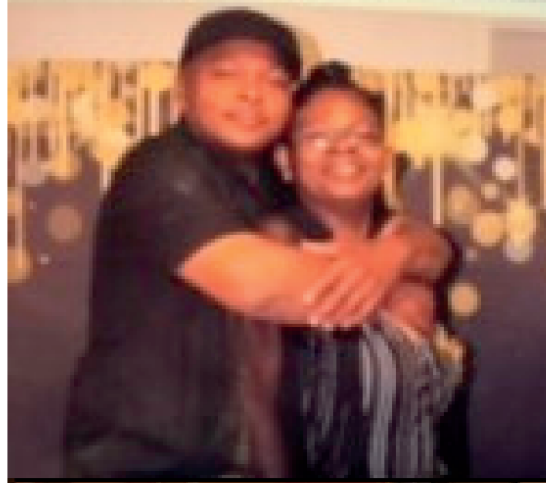
Stanley Phillip Dominick, Sr.
