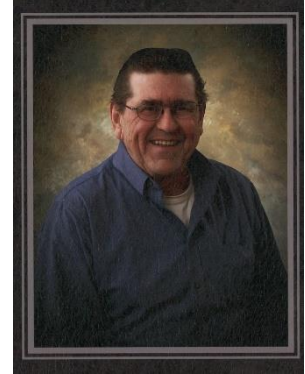


William E. “Bill” Brusky
