Winston worked many jobs as a young man including a self-employed Master Electrician and a Construction Laborer. In later years, his family brought him to America for more opportunities and Winston continued to work many jobs to support his family and lifestyle.

Winston began his work here at GNJ as a Senior Aide and Bus Monitor on October 16th, 2014 under the supervision of Mrs. Regina Johnson, Project Director. Prior to his hire, he trained for two years under the NCBA (National Council of the Black Aged). Winston was very sensitive to the needs of our seniors and was very well liked and respected by the caregivers and staff.

Winston continued his employment at GNJ until his retirement on September 30th, 2020 at the age of 76.
