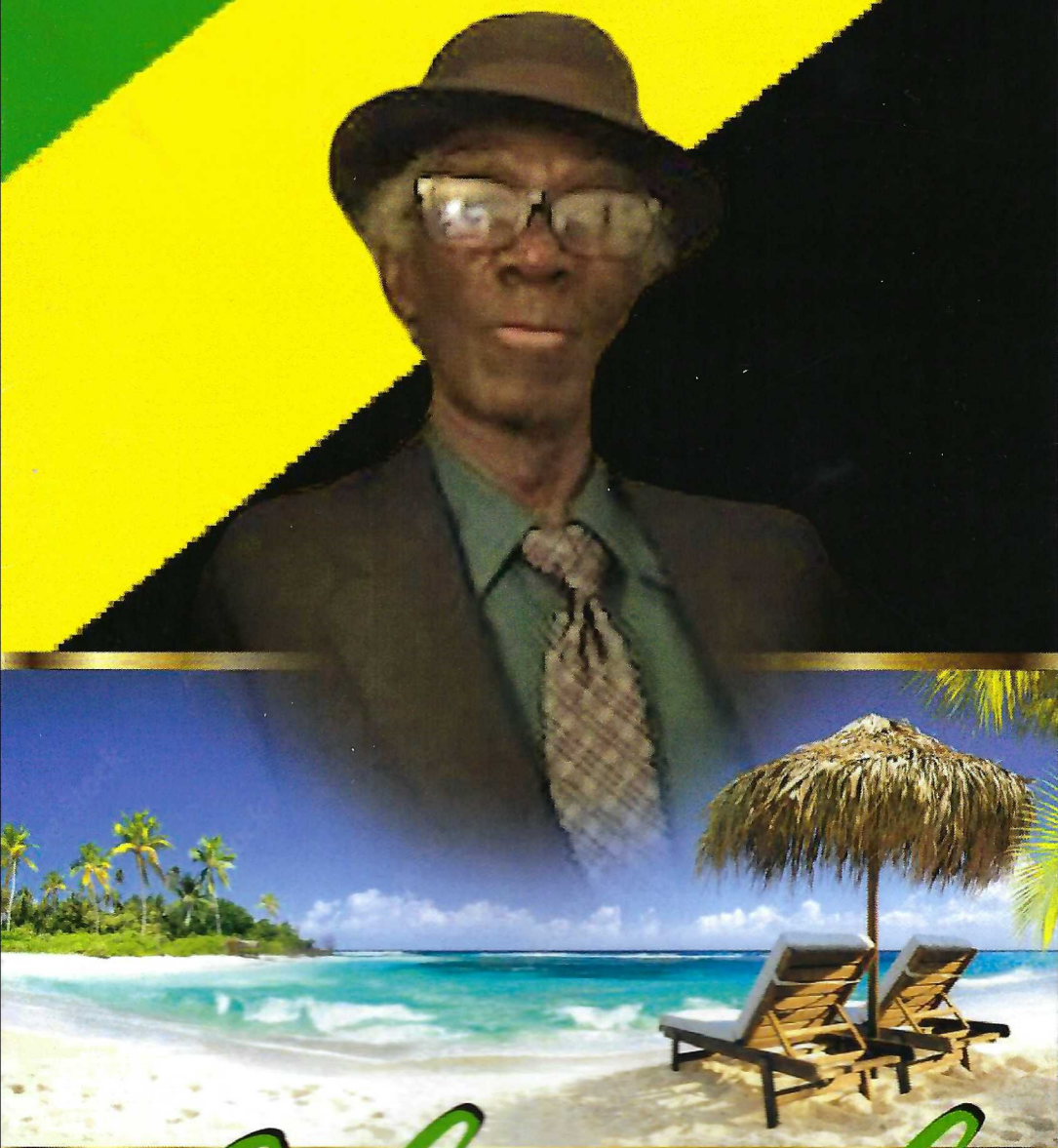

His Journey

Edward Alexander Grant, 86, left us on February 3, 2022, at home with his daughter Jennifer Grant at his bedside. God saw it fit that it was time for his son to rest.

Edward was born on May 20, 1935, in St. Catherine, Jamaica to the late Bertel and Victoria Grant. He was the first of eleven children. He attended Tulloch Primary. Mr. Grant learned the trade of Cabinet Making (carpentry) at an early age at Collins' Furniture in St. Catherine, Jamaica. At the age of 16 or 17, he moved to Kingston, Jamaica to start a new life. He stayed with his aunt Icilda Hines before moving on his own to start his family.

Mr. Grant has a total of seven children. He fathered six with Eugena Simms Bucknall, Vivienne Creary, Jennifer Grant, Michael Grant, Adassa Grant, Beaulett Lawrence (husband Gerald), and Christopher Grant (wife Colleen). He also fathered one son with Esmina Henry, Emelio Grant.

Mr. Grant mastered the trade of Cabinet Making and was well known on the island due to his skills and perfection. He could make anything from dining room to living room furniture to caskets. He was a hard worker and very dedicated to his trade. Mr. Grant would work all through the night at times to get a job done, especially at Christmas time. He was funny and a good Domino player. Mr. Grant was so good at dominos that he earned the name "Real Kill". He rarely lost playing the game and everyone wanted to be his partner when playing.

Mr. Grant immigrated to the United States on February 3, 1993, to be with his children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. In the United States, he worked for himself as a carpenter fixing houses, making decks and so forth. He was always ready to fix whatever needed fixing. He had many skills and was a perfectionist in whatever he worked on.

Edward was preceded in death by three sisters and two brothers. He is survived by his seven children, 19 grandchildren, 34 great-grandchildren, four sisters, one brother, 11 nieces, 11 nephews, cousins, and friends. Mr. Edward A. Grant spent his latter days visiting his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. He always quoted 2 Thessalonians 3:10 which states, "that if any would not work, neither should he eat". In Mr. Grant words, "Man whe nuh wuk nuh fe eat."

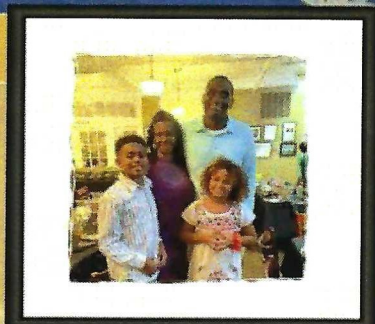
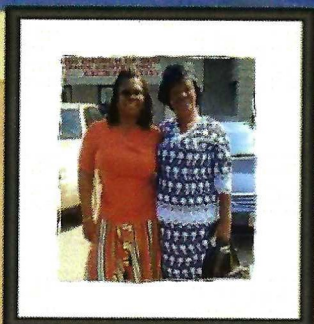

Nearer My God To Thee

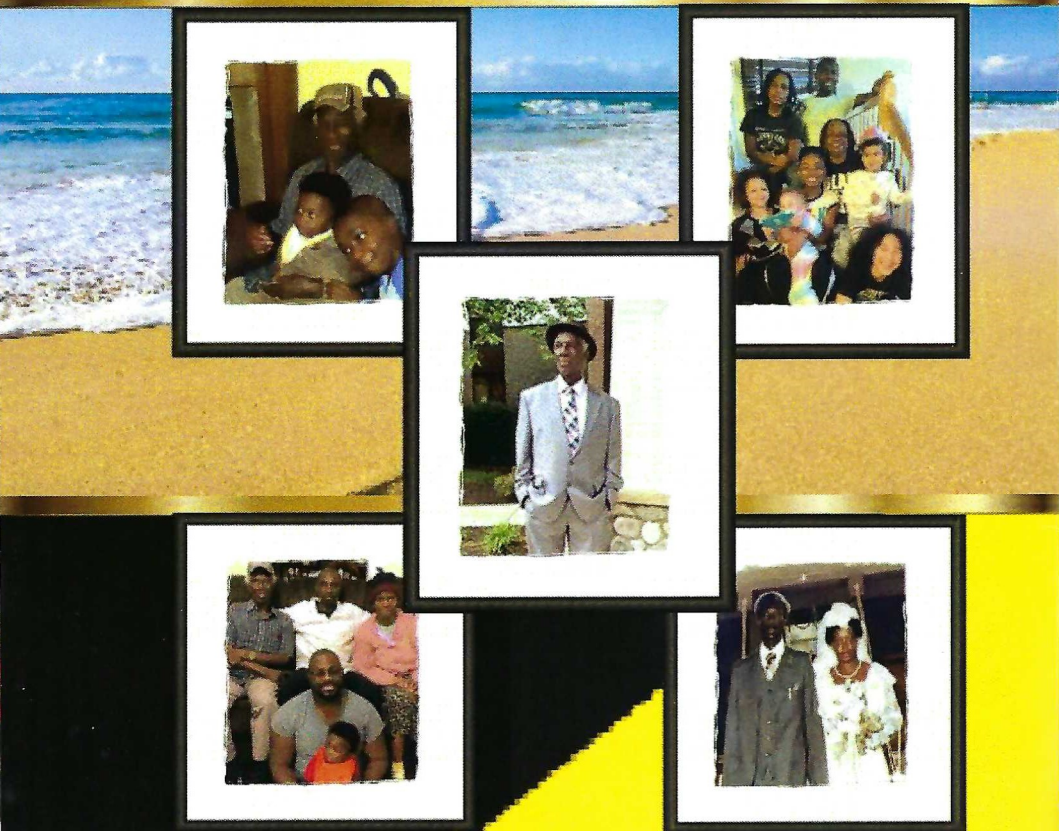
1. Nearer my God, to thee,
