but his memories will live on.*

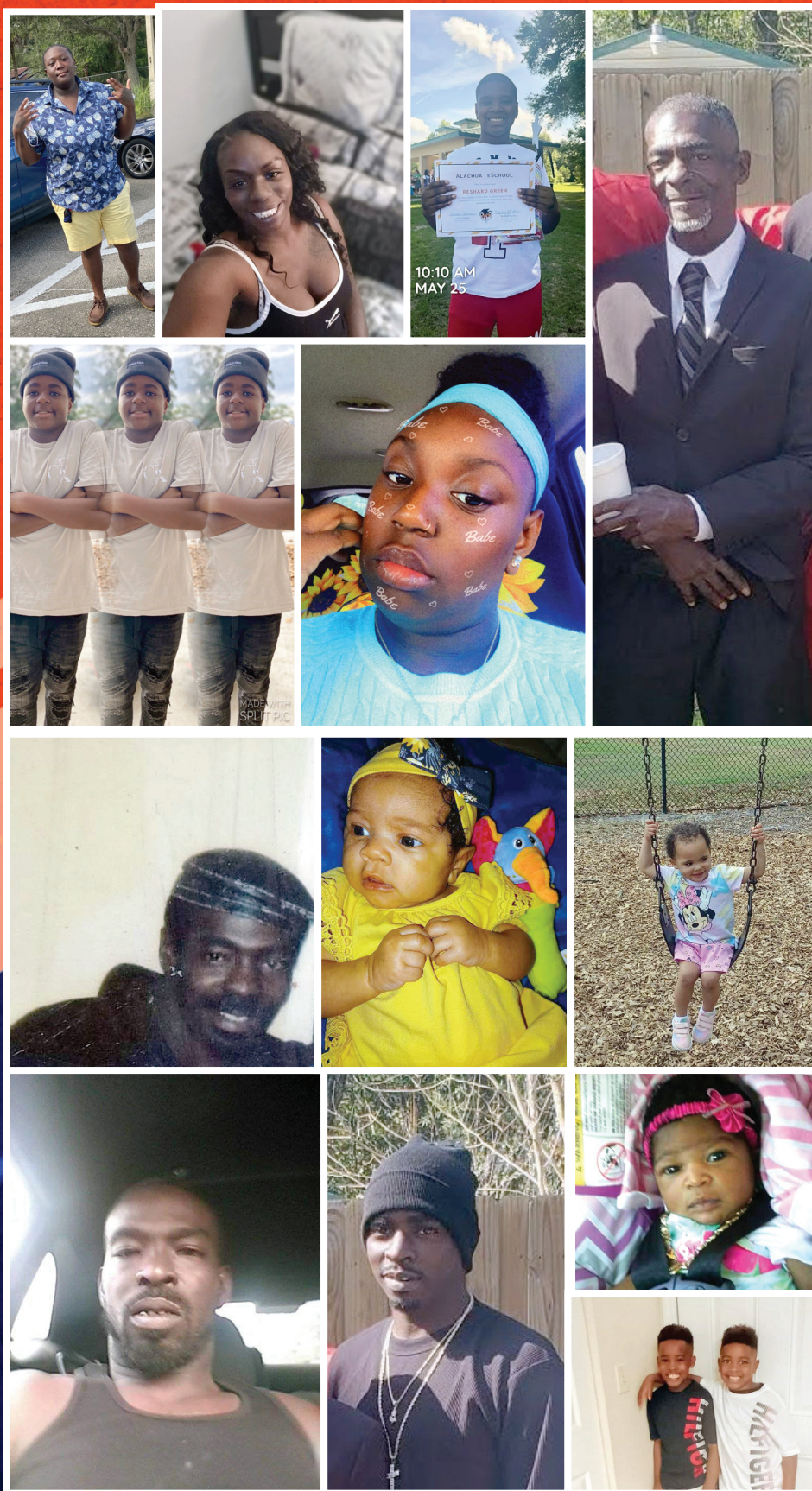
