De'Anthony accepted Christ at an early age in St. Louis, MO, where he served as a Junior Usher. He also continued to attend church once he moved to Kansas City.

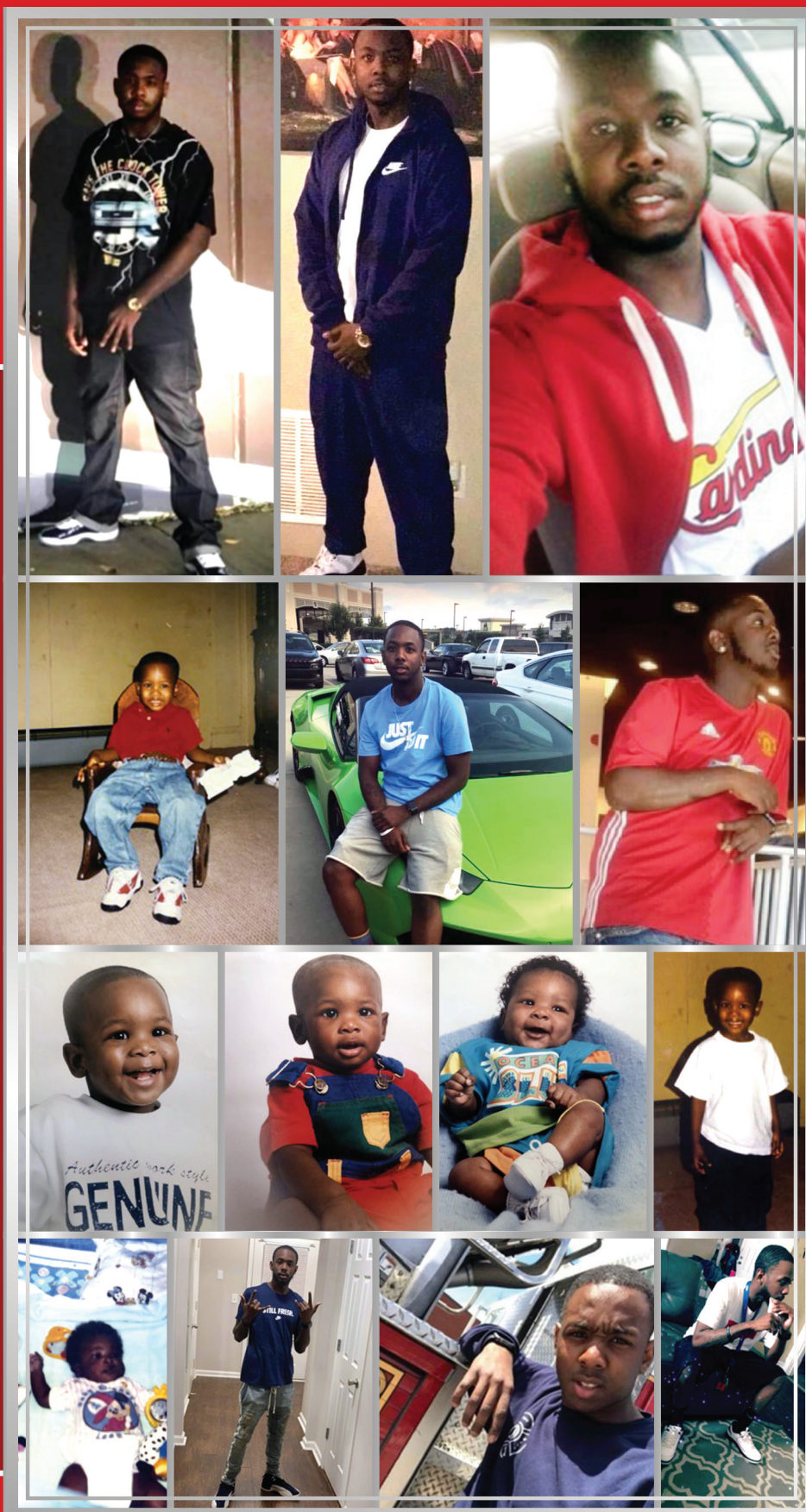
